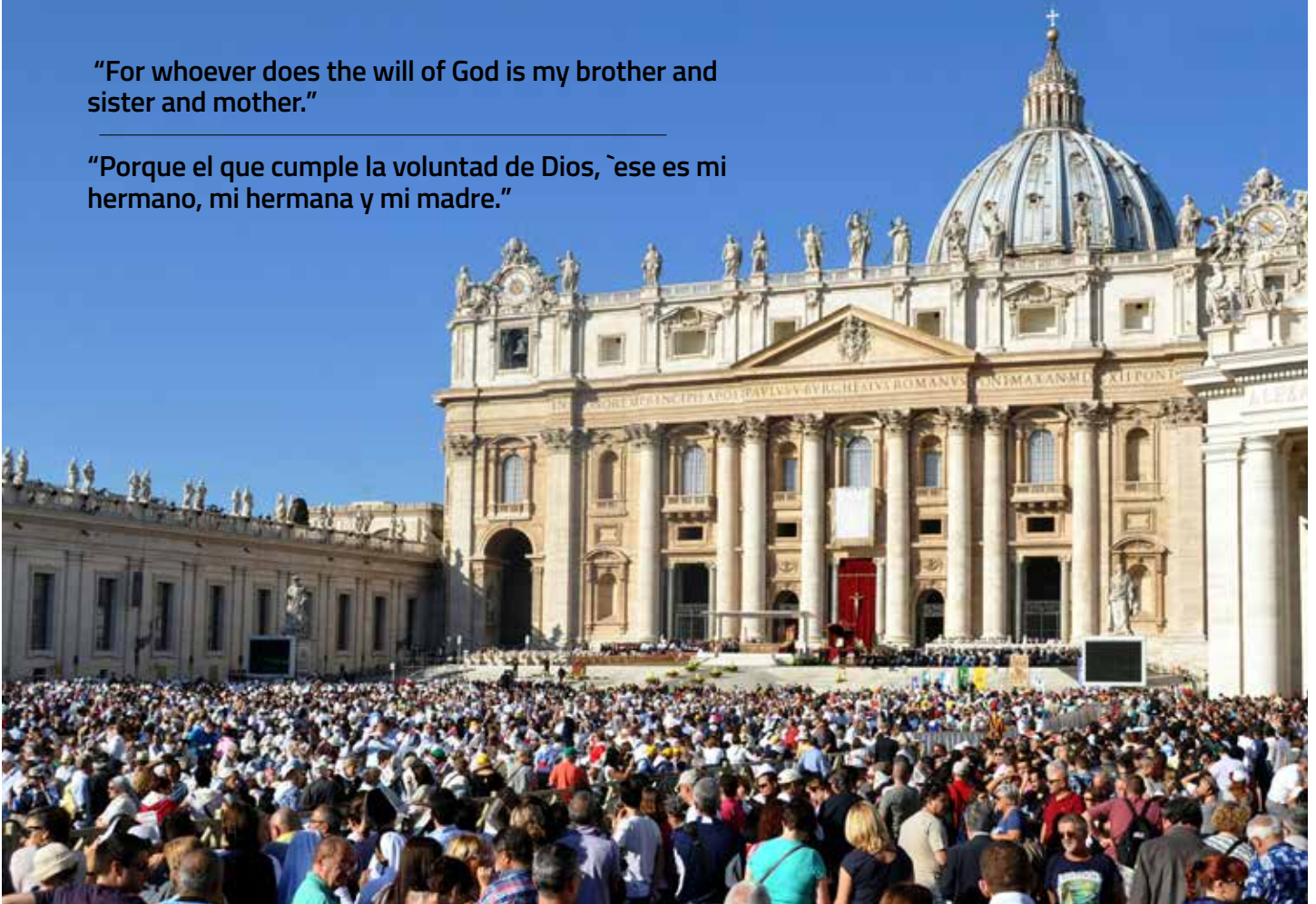

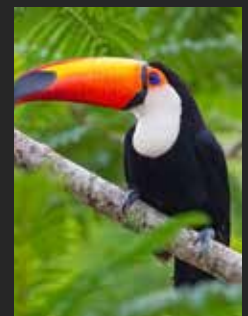

LET YOUR SOUL BE FREE...

Roman Guardini (priest, writer, and academician) writes, "... Open your hearts, lift up your eyes. Let your soul be free, for this is God's temple. It is likewise the representation of you, yourself. For you, your soul and your body are the living temple of God. Open up that temple, make it spacious, give it height." This thought reminds us of the necessity before arriving to church and before celebrating the Mass our disposition and preparation for celebrating Mass.

It also reminds us that the church first and foremost is a sacred space. We do not decorate or arrange our church like a "showcase" or a museum. The aesthetics and beauty of the church is to contribute to our private and communal prayer and worship. The signs and symbols incorporated in the church and Eucharistic Adoration Chapel are conduits that aid in our focus upon almighty God, assisting us in coming present before the God who steadfastly remains present to His children.

"Of small use to you is a house of wood and stone unless you yourself are God's living dwelling. The high arched gates may be lifted up, and the portals parted wide, but unless the doors of your heart are open, how can the King of Glory enter in?" Guardini.



It is this idea that has been the driving force in renovating the church and creating the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel. These signs and symbols become "windows" that have us see God in His heaven and glory. We are reminded, by them, of God's closeness, not God's remoteness from his people.

The Eucharistic Adoration Chapel, as with the church, are renovated with "just enough" not to distract us from God's sacred presence at Mass, but rather, they keep us focused and steadfast to our reason for being there; our reason to praise and worship God; and our reason for being a faith community. May you and I (personally and communally) take advantage of the awe, joy, and wonder of our Roman Catholic Faith Tradition. May we rightfully dispose ourselves by positioning ourselves to the miracle of the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Peace and grace. Fr. Russell

LA ESTACIÓN DE VERANO

Al acercarnos a la estación de verano, muchas parejas alrededor del mundo estarán entrando en el Matrimonio. En nuestra tradición de Fe Católica Romana, el Matrimonio es un pacto, sacramento, y vocación. Las enseñanzas de la Iglesia sobre el sacramento del Matrimonio reflejan que la vida de comunión es integral al “ser humano”. A pesar de que hay diferentes tipos y maneras de estar en comunión con otros, el sacramento del Matrimonio resalta esta comunión y nos recuerda que estamos llamados a vivir por el otro, no solo para uno mismo. Cuando uno se casa, uno de sus compromisos es que ella/el desea la satisfacción del otro, que es para lo que Dios ha llamado y creado a la persona. Por lo tanto, es una vocación y llamado en el cual cada uno vive su vida en una forma específica para la salvación del otro (integridad).

El Sacramento del Matrimonio es un pacto – un acuerdo obligatorio en el que ambos vivirán concretamente su vocación y sacramento en una manera digna y honorable, reflejando el amor de Dios por la gente de Dios y el amor de Cristo Jesús por su Iglesia. Y este acuerdo no solo involucra a la pareja de casados, sin la gracia y la presencia de Dios, el Matrimonio se vuelve algo funcional y totalmente dependiente de la pareja. Dios es el autor y fuente de vida y del vivir.



Cada persona en el Matrimonio tiene una responsabilidad de vivir este Sacramento. Sin embargo, sin la presencia y reconocimiento de la presencia activa y salvífica de Dios, nos convertimos en creadores y autores de nuestra vocación. Y hay el riesgo que la relación se vuelva egoísta y dañina para el otro. Debemos recordar que Dios nos amó primero. Dios empezó; nosotros respondemos a través de cómo vivimos.

¿Por qué nuestra tradición de Fe Católica Romana llama al Matrimonio un sacramento?

Los sacramentos son encuentros fundamentales de la vida humana y la relación con Dios. Los Matrimonios pueden ser reconocidos por la Iglesia, y aún no estar reconocidos como sacramentales. Los sacramentos elevan esos encuentros esenciales entre el Misterio Pascual de Dios en Cristo Jesús y la humanidad. El Sacramento del Matrimonio se convierte (como todos los Sacramentos lo hacen) en un canal de la gracia de Dios para nosotros. Lo natural y lo humano se conducen a comprometer la vida del uno con la del otro y se convierten en un agente activo de la presencia de Jesucristo en el mundo. El pecado ha distorsionado la naturaleza del ser humano, y los Sacramentos restauran la naturaleza humana y las relaciones humanas hacia el plan y propósito original de Dios. Los Sacramentos regalan la gracia vivificante de Cristo Jesús. Hay reglas y procedimientos para el Sacramento del Matrimonio. Esta es la razón por la cual hay clases de preparación a cargo de instructores diocesanos; reuniones con un sacerdote; y una evaluación pre - matrimonial de los requerimientos. Estas herramientas son oportunidades para las parejas con el fin de que tengan un mayor conocimiento y apreciación de esta maravilloso Sacramento. Asimismo, esto ayuda a conocer a las parejas sobre la importancia y seriedad del Matrimonio. Les sugerimos tomar esta orientación positiva y llena de gracia acerca de este maravilloso Sacramento.

Animamos e invitamos a las parejas a hacer una cita para reunirse con un sacerdote. Quizá existan impedimentos (obstáculos o circunstancias) en las parejas e incluso preguntas. Estamos aquí para discernir con ustedes como sus abogados y padres espirituales, no como un capataz que quiere hacerlo saltar entre aros. Dejemos que Jesucristo les revele la gloria y el esplendor del Matrimonio.

Matrimonios Se debe hacer una cita con el Padre Luis para abrir el expediente matrimonial por lo menos 6 meses antes de la fecha de Boda. Hay que estar registrados en la parroquia un mínimo de seis meses antes de abrir el expediente matrimonial con asistencia regular a la Santa Misa. Se necesitan las partidas de bautismo ACTUALIZADAS no más de seis meses y han de ser originales, no copias.

Quinceañeras Las quinceañeras tienen que haber hecho la Primera Comunión y necesitan comprobante de haberlo hecho. La familia tiene que estar inscrita en la parroquia un mínimo de seis meses antes de reservar la Iglesia para la quinceañera con asistencia regular a la Santa Misa y ha de estar activa o en la doctrina o en el grupo juvenil o en un grupo parroquial con asistencia regular comprobada.



Confesiones El Padre Luis confiesa por 1 hora todos los Sábados antes de la Santa Misa. Aquellos que deseen confesarse, por favor, llegar a la Iglesia por lo menos media hora antes de la Santa Misa.
