"God is able to make every grace abundant for you, so that in all things, always having all you need, you may have an abundance for every good work," (2 Corinthians 9:8). My sisters and brothers, many thanks and blessings to all of you who have participated and increased from last year your commitment to our 2017 Catholic Faith Appeal (CFA). As of July 9th, our parish has pledged \$235,486.36 and collected \$208,000.36.

In exceeding our CFA goal of \$203,000, we not only look at "going beyond a dollar amount. We are pledging ourselves in that our fulfillment of Jesus' Gospel message and command to us His disciples: "Proclaim that the Kingdom of God is at hand! Cure the sick; comfort the afflicted; console those who mourn!" The real pledge is our conviction and commitment to what Christ Jesus preached and did- a pledge to His truth that where there is decay, we will be salt; where there is darkness, we will be light.

And so, in gratitude to God for everyone's participation in spreading the gospel not just "in word or speech but in deed and truth (1 John 3:18), let us honor our pledge to give glory and honor to God; fulfill our pledge so that Jesus' mission and ministry continue; and continue to pattern our behavior after God's behavior that love is generous in all things, for all people.

CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING IMMIGRATION

The Catholic Catechism instructs the faithful that good government has two duties, both of which must be carried out and neither of which can be ignored.

The first duty is to welcome the foreigner out of charity and respect for the human person. Persons have the right to immigrate and thus government must accommodate this right to the greatest extent possible, especially financially blessed nations: "The more prosperous nations are obliged, to the extent they are able, to welcome the foreigner in search of the security and the means of livelihood which he cannot find in his country of origin. Public authorities should see to it that the natural right is respected that places a guest under the protection of those who receive him." Catholic Catechism, 2241.

The second duty is to secure one's border and enforce the law for the sake of the common good. Sovereign nations have the right to enforce their laws and all persons must respect the legitimate

exercise of this right: "Political authorities, for the sake of the common good for which they are responsible may make the exercise of the right to immigrate subject to various juridical conditions, especially with regard to the immigrants' duties toward their country of adoption. Immigrants are obliged to respect with gratitude the material and spiritual heritage of the country that receives them, to obey its laws and to assist in carrying civic burdens." Catholic Catechism, 2241.

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) opposes "enforcement only" immigration policies and supports comprehensive immigration reform.

Se necesitan las partidas de bautismo ACTUALIZADAS no más de seis meses y han de ser originales, no copias.

Quinceañeras

Las quinceañeras tienen que haber hecho la Primera Comuni3n y necesitan comprobante de haberlo hecho. La familia tiene que estar inscrita en la parroquia un mínimo de seis meses antes de reservar la Iglesia para la quinceañera con asistencia regular a la Santa Misa y ha de estar activa o en la doctrina o en el grupo juvenil o en un grupo parroquial con asistencia regular comprobada.



Confesiones

El Padre Luis confiesa por 45 minutos todos los Sábados antes de la Santa Misa. Aquellos que deseen confesarse, por favor, llegar a la Iglesia por lo menos media hora antes de la Santa Misa.
