SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING SESSIONS

As part of the Safe Environment Program, the Diocese of Venice requires that all employees and any/all volunteers who work or minister with children and/or vulnerable adults are both to be fingerprinted and trained in Safe Environment awareness issues. No exceptions are permitted by the Diocese. These safeguards protect both the employee/volunteer/minister and those whom they encounter.

If you are involved in Faith Formation and/or Youth Ministry as a catechist and/or an aid, an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist to the homebound, AVOW Hospice, or the hospital, or assist in any ministry or program that is a direct involvement with children, youth or vulnerable adults, you must fulfill these two requirements.

Additionally, fingerprinting is to occur every 5 years. Are you current? We will be able to tell you. Please call the office at 239-455-3900 and speak with Pamela. The parish will reimburse those who are unable to pay for fingerprinting. The following parishes are holding sessions.
