We hope that this schedule will provide sufficient time for our priests, musicians, sacristans, and congregation to prepare properly for the Liturgy.

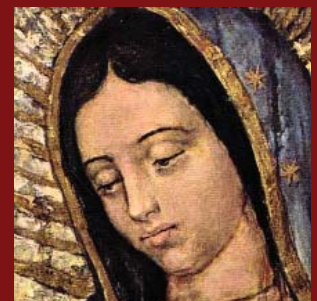
