



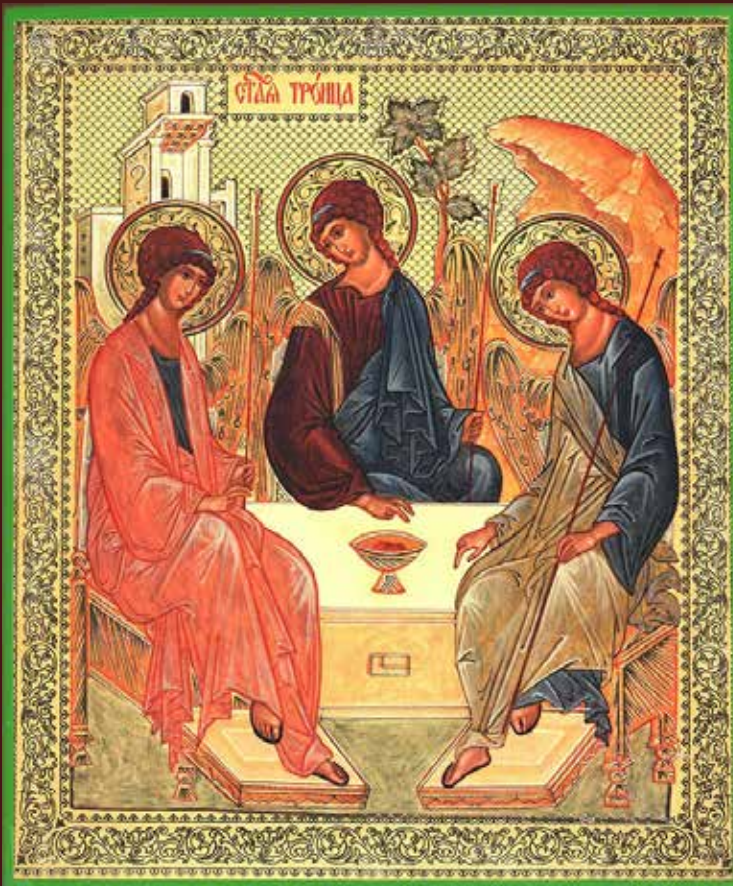

Trinity Sunday

STEWARDSHIP = RE-GIFTING

"All tithes of the land, whether in grain from the fields or in fruit from the trees, belong to the Lord; they are sacred to the Lord." Leviticus 27:30

During the Christmas season, "re-gifting" is prevalent. The blue shirt with neon green piping given to me by great-cousin Alphonso is then given by me to my great-nephew, who re-gifted it to his girlfriend's sister's boyfriend. That sweater has traveled more times and to various places than a Carnival Cruise Line!

In a spiritual and theological sense, stewardship is a holy type of re-gifting. It is not that we give what we do not want. Rather, we give because we desire to share what is good that we possess, whether that be talent, time, or treasure. What we give to the Lord and others is sacred because the Lord God has creation is sacred and freely given. Stewardship regards the sacred value of ourselves, others, and what both can share with one another for communion in the community. If the sacred remains hoarded and isolated, does it risk becoming corrosive?

Consequently, stewardship is based on an individual's **need** to give, not on the other's need to receive. According to the International Theological Commission's work entitled *Communion and Stewardship: Human Persons Created in the Image of God*, "The created image affirmed by the Old Testament is, according to the New Testament, to be completed in the imago Christi [Image of Christ];" Chapter 1, 11. We need to give because we are created in the image and likeness of a God who is the Divine Giver and Steward. Each of the three Divine Persons in the Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) exists for the Others and joyful shares what He possesses with the other because of this awareness that what one gives is something sacred and blessed. Because of our brokenness and woundedness resulting from Sin, we can perceive that what we possess either has no sacredness or that its value is greater than to share with anyone, especially if we feel that others are unworthy or not valuable.

Stewardship, then, is living with gratitude and joy because God provides us an opportunity to share the sacredness of our talent, time, and treasure. It is sacred because they become the manifestations and means to share a part of ourselves so that others never remain apart from one another. Stewardship creates a conviction and commitment of thanksgiving to God that we have something of value (ourselves) so that we can share with others and enrich their and our lives. And by engaging in stewardship, we gain greater appreciation of God having shared with us invaluable gifts. We appreciate ourselves as recipients: vessels filled with good wine to be poured out as libations that refresh others.

I conclude with a quote from Bishop Robert J. Rose of Grand Rapids, Michigan: "Stewardship is not just one more thing, one more program, one more way of getting things done or of raising money. It is the way of life of disciples of the Lord Jesus. It is following the Lord Jesus on the way of gratitude and generosity." I invite and welcome anyone to call the office to schedule an appointment with me to assist in discerning with you about your role as a steward in our parish. Do not pass by this opportunity of God's grace and gift to share yourself. Peace and grace, Fr. Russell

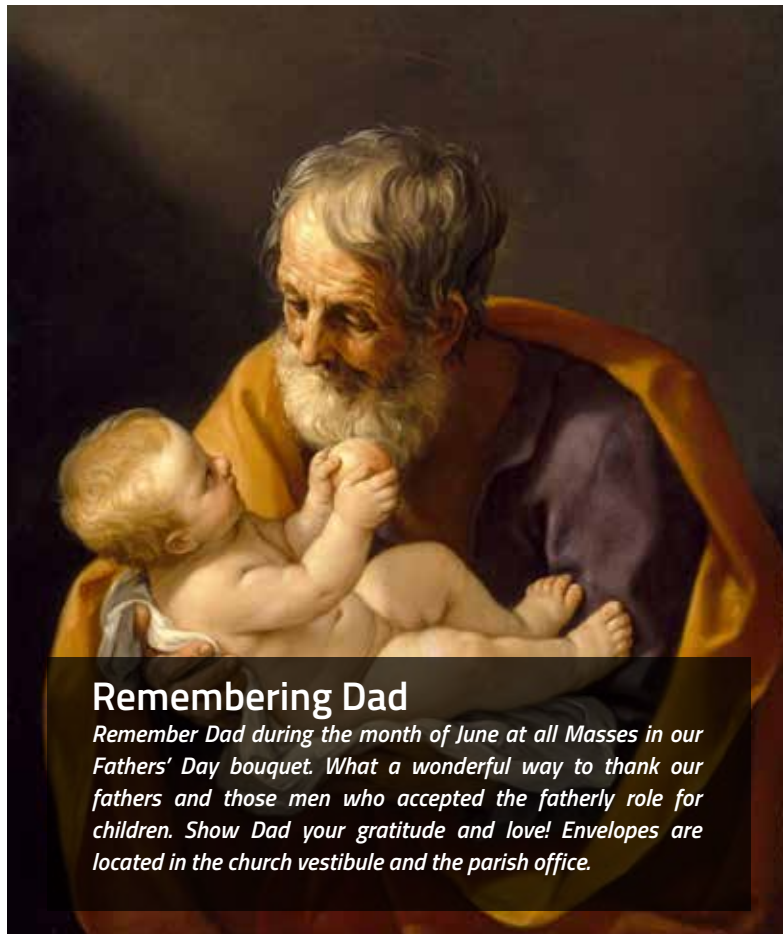

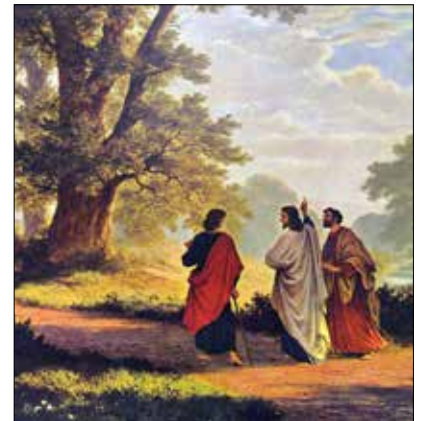
DE PADRE...

Todos los diezmos de la tierra, ya sea en el grano de los campos o en el fruto de los árboles, pertenecen al Señor; son sagrados para el Señor ". Levítico 27:30

Durante la temporada de Navidad, "regalar" es frecuente. La camisa azul con banda verde neón que me regaló el primo hermano Alphonso la entrego a mi sobrino nieto, quien se la regaló al novio de la hermana de su novia. ¡Ese suéter ha viajado más veces y a varios lugares que un barco de vacaciones de Carnival Cruise Line!

En un sentido espiritual y teológico, la mayordomía es una forma sagrada de regalar. No es que demos lo que no queremos. Más bien, damos porque deseamos compartir lo que es bueno que poseemos, ya sea talento, tiempo o tesoro. Lo que le damos al Señor y a los demás es sagrado porque para el Señor Dios la creación es sagrada y se da libremente. La corresponsabilidad se refiere al valor sagrado de nosotros mismos, de los demás, y de lo que ambos pueden compartir entre ellos para la comunión en la comunidad. Si lo sagrado permanece atesorado y aislado, ¿corre el riesgo de volverse corrosivo?

En consecuencia, la corresponsabilidad se basa en la necesidad de un individuo de dar, y no en la necesidad de recibir del otro. Según el trabajo de la Comisión Teológica Internacional titulado Comunión y mayordomía: personas humanas creadas a imagen de Dios, "La imagen creada afirmada por el Antiguo Testamento es, según el Nuevo Testamento, completada en la imago Christi [Imagen de Cristo] , "Capítulo 1, 11. Necesitamos dar porque somos creados a imagen y semejanza de un Dios que es Dador y Mayordomo Divino. Cada una de las tres Personas Divinas en la



Trinidad (Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo) existe para los Otros y comparte alegremente lo que posee con el otro debido a esta conciencia de que lo que uno da es algo sagrado y bendito. Debido a nuestro quebranto y heridas resultantes del pecado, podemos percibir que lo que poseemos no tiene carácter sagrado o que su valor es mayor que compartir con alguien, especialmente si sentimos que los demás son indignos o no valiosos.

La mayordomía, entonces, es vivir con gratitud y alegría porque Dios nos da la oportunidad de compartir lo sagrado de nuestro talento, tiempo y tesoro. Es sagrado porque se convierten en las manifestaciones y los medios para compartir una parte de nosotros mismos para que los demás nunca permanezcan separados unos de otros. La mayordomía crea una convicción y un compromiso de acción de gracias a Dios de que tenemos algo de valor (nosotros mismos) para poder compartir con los demás y enriquecer su vida y la nuestra. Y al comprometernos en la mayordomía, ganamos una mayor apreciación de que Dios haya compartido con nosotros regalos invaluable. Nos apreciamos como recipientes: recipientes llenos de buen vino para ser derramados como libaciones que refrescan a otros.

Concluyo con una cita del Obispo Robert J. Rose de Grand Rapids, Michigan: "La mayordomía no es solo una cosa más, un programa más, una forma más de hacer las cosas o de recaudar dinero. Es la forma de vida de los discípulos del Señor Jesús. Es seguir al Señor Jesús en el camino de gratitud y generosidad. "Invito y doy la bienvenida a cualquiera que llame a la oficina para programar una cita conmigo para ayudar a discernir con usted acerca de su papel como mayordomo en nuestra parroquia. No pase esta oportunidad de la gracia y el don de Dios de compartir. Paz y gracia, p. Russell
