



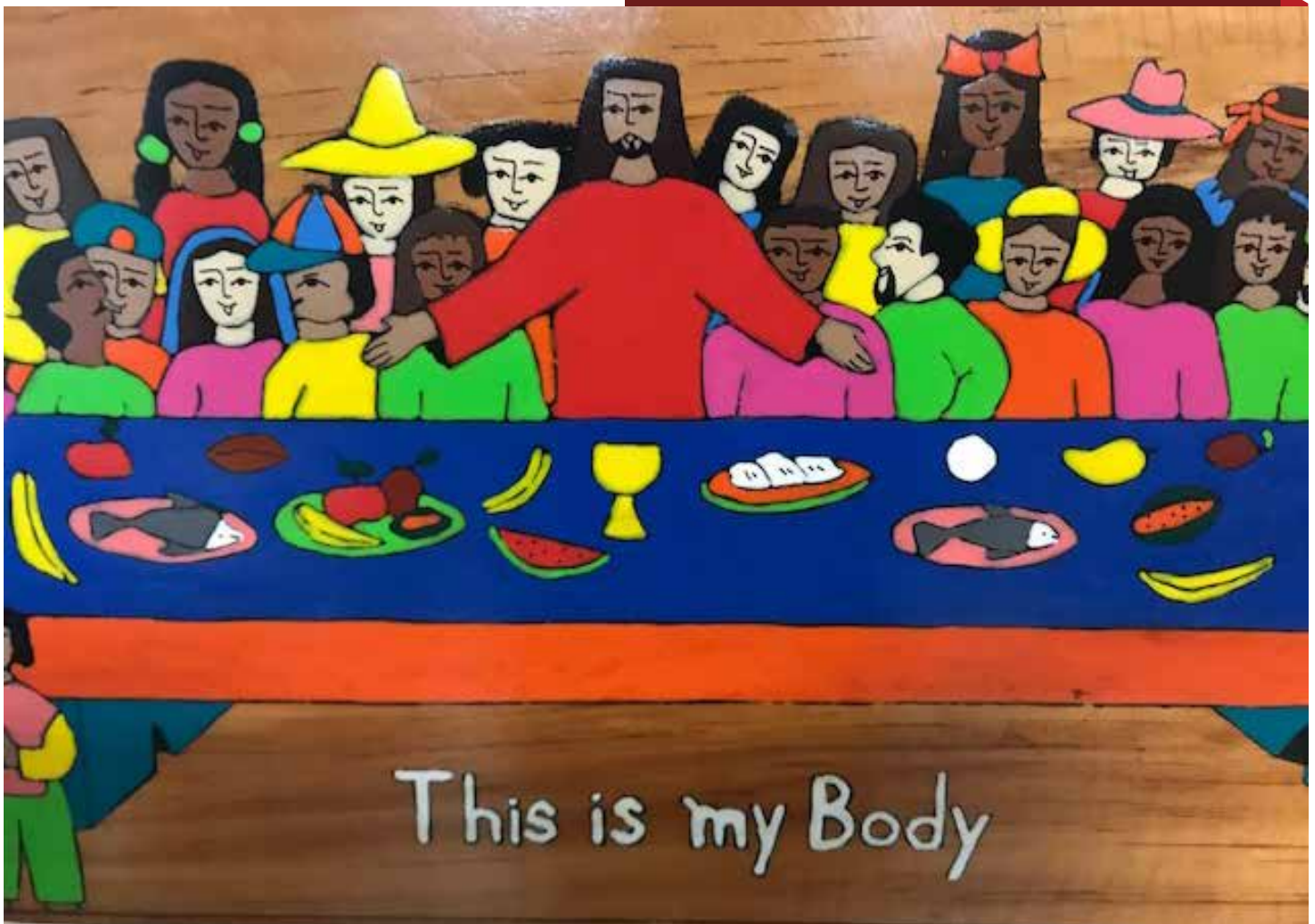

ON THE SOLEMN FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

As we celebrate the Solemn feast of Corpus Christi (the Body of Christ), it is an opportunity for some reminders. If receiving Eucharist on the tongue, please protrude the tongue out far enough so that there is no contact between the minister's fingers and your tongue. When receiving the Eucharist in one's hand, please be certain that your hands are clean. It is proper to receive Eucharist in the palm of one's hand, not between the fingers.

Also, when possible, one should avoid leaving after Holy Communion. When the minister says, "The Body/Blood of Christ," the response is "Amen." This witnesses not only to the real sacramental presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. It also confirms that we have come into communion with Christ Jesus in the Eucharist as a member of the Faith Community. We stay afterwards as a sign of this greater communion of ALL OF US with the Risen Christ in the Eucharist.



Additionally, this is the reason that the minister does NOT say, "This is the Body/Blood of Christ." Yes, the Eucharist is the Body of Christ; however, the Church is the Mystical Body of Christ; and you and I are called to be the Body of Christ. The reality and truth of the Eucharist is meant to manifest our reality and truth: we and other members are to be transfigured and transformed into Christ Jesus as the Eucharistic Lord.

As Eucharist, we are called to create communion and life by self-donation and service. Bishop Robert Barron writes, "Jesus vanished immediately after being recognized by the two Emmaus disciples because he 'disappears into the mission of the Church.'" We are members of the Church and Her mission. He transfigures the Church and Her children (us), so that we continue to "feed those who hunger." Let us never betray that great gift that Jesus has given: Himself as the bread of life, the cup of salvation, the Lord who saves His people through His people. Peace. -Fr. Russell

SOLEMNE FIESTA DE CORPUS CHRISTI

Ante la celebración de la fiesta solemne del Corpus Christi (el Cuerpo de Cristo), sea esta una oportunidad para algunos recordatorios. Si Ud. recibe la Eucaristía en la lengua, por favor, saque la lengua lo suficiente como para que no haya contacto entre los dedos del ministro y su lengua. En el mismo sentido, si Ud. recibe la Eucaristía en la mano, asegúrese de tener las manos limpias. Además, es apropiado recibir la Eucaristía en la palma de la mano, no entre los dedos.

Adicionalmente, cuando sea posible, uno debe evitar irse después de la Sagrada Comunión. Cuando el ministro dice: "El Cuerpo/la Sangre de Cristo", la respuesta debe ser "Amén". Esto como un testimonio no solo de la verdadera presencia sacramental de Jesús en la Eucaristía, sino también como un modo de confirmar que hemos entrado en comunión con Jesucristo, como miembros de la comunidad de Fe, en la Eucaristía. Al quedarnos hasta el final, somos un signo de esta mayor comunión de TODOS NOSOTROS con Cristo Resucitado en la Eucaristía.

Igualmente, esta es la razón por la cual el ministro NO dice: "Este es el Cuerpo / Sangre de Cristo". Sí, la Eucaristía es el Cuerpo de Cristo; sin embargo, la Iglesia es el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo; y usted y yo estamos llamados a ser el Cuerpo de Cristo. La realidad y la verdad de la Eucaristía están destinadas a manifestar nuestra realidad y verdad: nosotros y otros miembros debemos ser transfigurados y transformados en Cristo Jesús como el Señor Eucarístico.

Como Eucaristía, estamos llamados a crear comunión y vida mediante la autodonación y el servicio. El Obispo Robert Barron escribe: "Jesús desapareció inmediatamente después de ser reconocido por los dos discípulos de Emaús porque 'desaparece en la misión de la Iglesia'". Somos miembros de la Iglesia y su misión. Él transfigura la Iglesia y Sus hijos (nosotros), para que continuemos "alimentando a los que tienen hambre". Nunca traicionemos ese gran regalo que Jesús ha dado: a sí mismo como el pan de vida, la copa de la salvación, el Señor que salva a su pueblo a través de su pueblo. Paz.
