Y es alrededor de estas dos cosas, la Palabra y la Eucaristía, que formamos comunidad, a partir de estos creamos la iglesia.



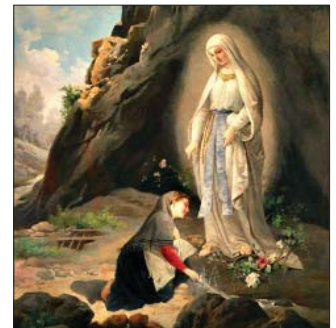
AQUÍ Y AHORA, POR EL PADRE

ADORATION CHAPEL STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

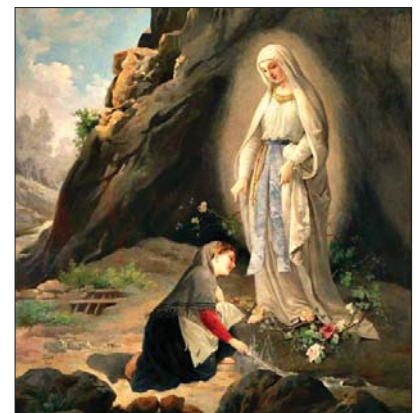
My sisters and brothers in Christ Jesus,

OUR LADY OF LOURDES MINISTRY

“WHEN I WAS SICK AND LONELY, YOU VISITED ME”

Our Lady of Lourdes Ministry is comprised of men and women who are Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist called to visit the homebound in the hospital, hospice or assisted living facilities. St. Elizabeth Seton Catholic Church is responsible for the ministerial care of the Roman Catholic patients at AVOW Hospice. Presently, this is the focus of our ministry, but we have a greater vision.
