



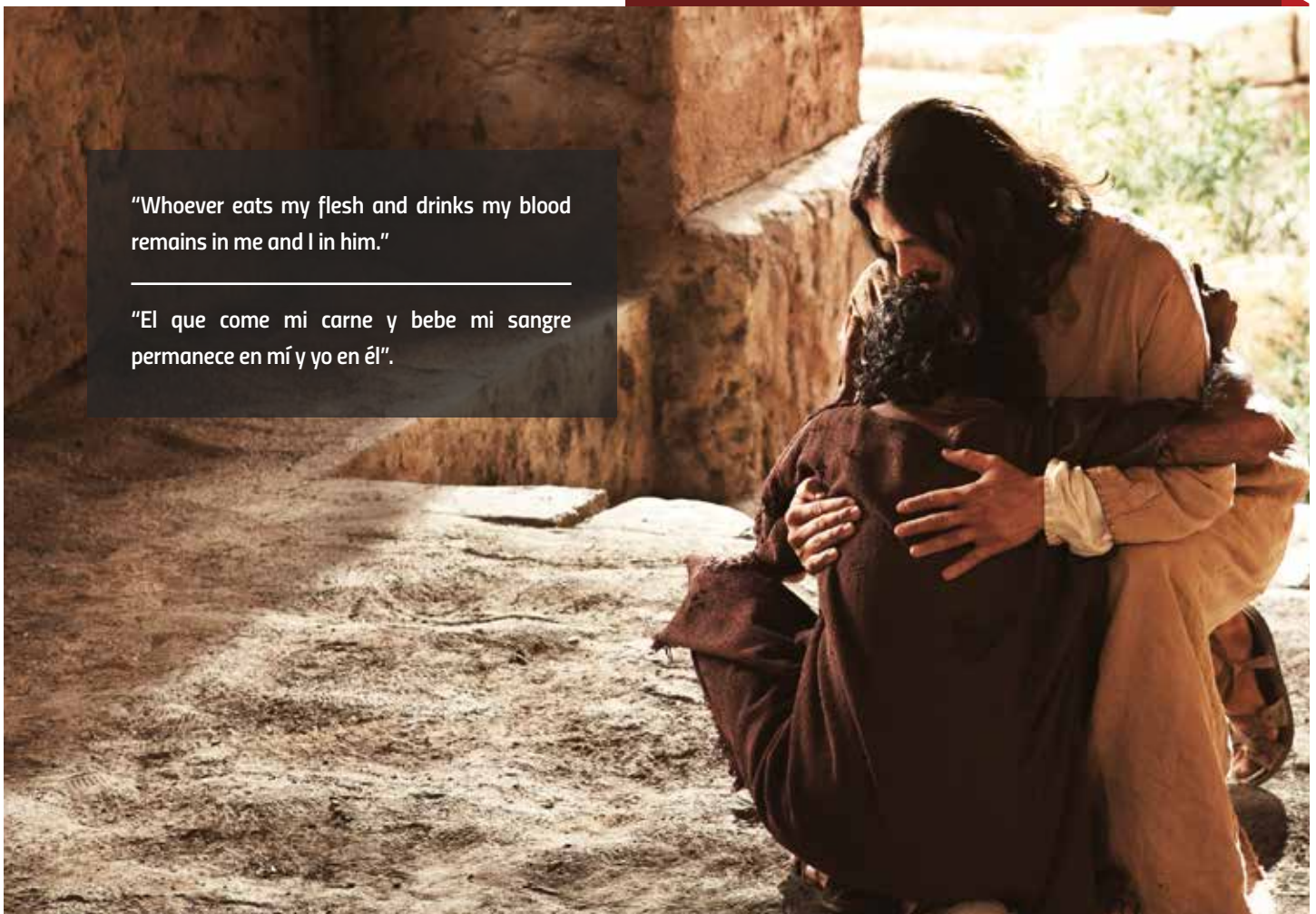

THE REAL PRESENCE OF CHRIST

"...[The] believing disciples were rewarded for their faith at the Last Supper. Jesus revealed that they would receive His true body and blood sacramentally (present in a hidden way). In the sacrament of the Eucharist, Christ's body and blood are truly present, but not with their normal physical properties. Jesus' body isn't spread out in space; its normal condition is hidden under the appearance of bread and wine. While the Apostles truly consumed Christ's real body and blood, it wasn't cannibalism, because Christ wasn't in His natural condition. They didn't bite off pieces of Christ's arm, for example, or swallow quantities of His blood; instead they received Christ whole and entire- body, blood, soul, and divinity- under the appearance of bread and wine. Receiving Christ's real, but sacramental presence in the Eucharist has nothing to do with cannibalism or drinking blood," *How to Explain and Defend the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist* by Father Frank Chacon & Jim Burnham.

Lectors: Those who have received Baptism and Eucharist and presently in sixth grade and up.

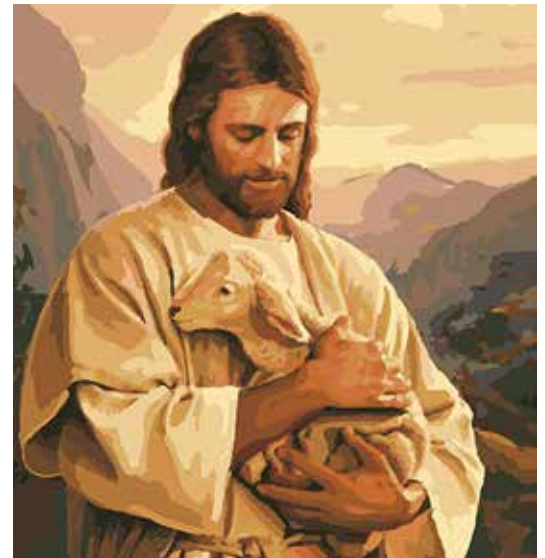
Ushers: Those who have received Baptism and from first grade and up.

By creating or participating in endowment funds, donors both confirm and extend beyond their lifetime a commitment and conviction to Christ Jesus' mission and ministry of the Gospel proclamation of God's Kingdom among us. Many endowment funds are created through gifts from wills or trusts, however, several donors choose to fund endowments while they are still living, so that they can see the fruit and impact of their commitment and support. There are numerous ways to fund an endowment including gifts of cash, securities, property, and more.

LA PRESENCIA REAL DE CRISTO

“... [Los] discípulos creyentes fueron recompensados por su fe en la Última Cena. Jesús reveló que recibirían Su cuerpo y sangre verdaderos sacramentalmente (presentes de forma oculta). En el sacramento de la Eucaristía, el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo están realmente presentes, pero no con sus propiedades físicas normales. El cuerpo de Jesús no se extiende en el espacio, su condición normal se esconde bajo la apariencia de pan y vino. Mientras que los Apóstoles realmente consumieron el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo, no fue canibalismo, porque Cristo no estaba en su condición natural. No mordieron pedazos del brazo de Cristo, por ejemplo, ni tragaron cantidades de su sangre, sino que recibieron a Cristo entero y cuerpo entero, sangre, alma y divinidad bajo la apariencia de pan y vino. Recibir la presencia real, pero sacramental de Cristo en la Eucaristía, no tiene nada que ver con el canibalismo o con beber sangre, “Cómo explicar y defender la presencia real de Cristo en la Eucaristía” por el Padre Frank Chacón y Jim Burnham.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES MINISTRY

"WHEN I WAS SICK AND LONELY, YOU VISITED ME"

Our Lady of Lourdes Ministry is comprised of men and women who are Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist called to visit the homebound in the hospital, hospice or assisted living facilities.
