



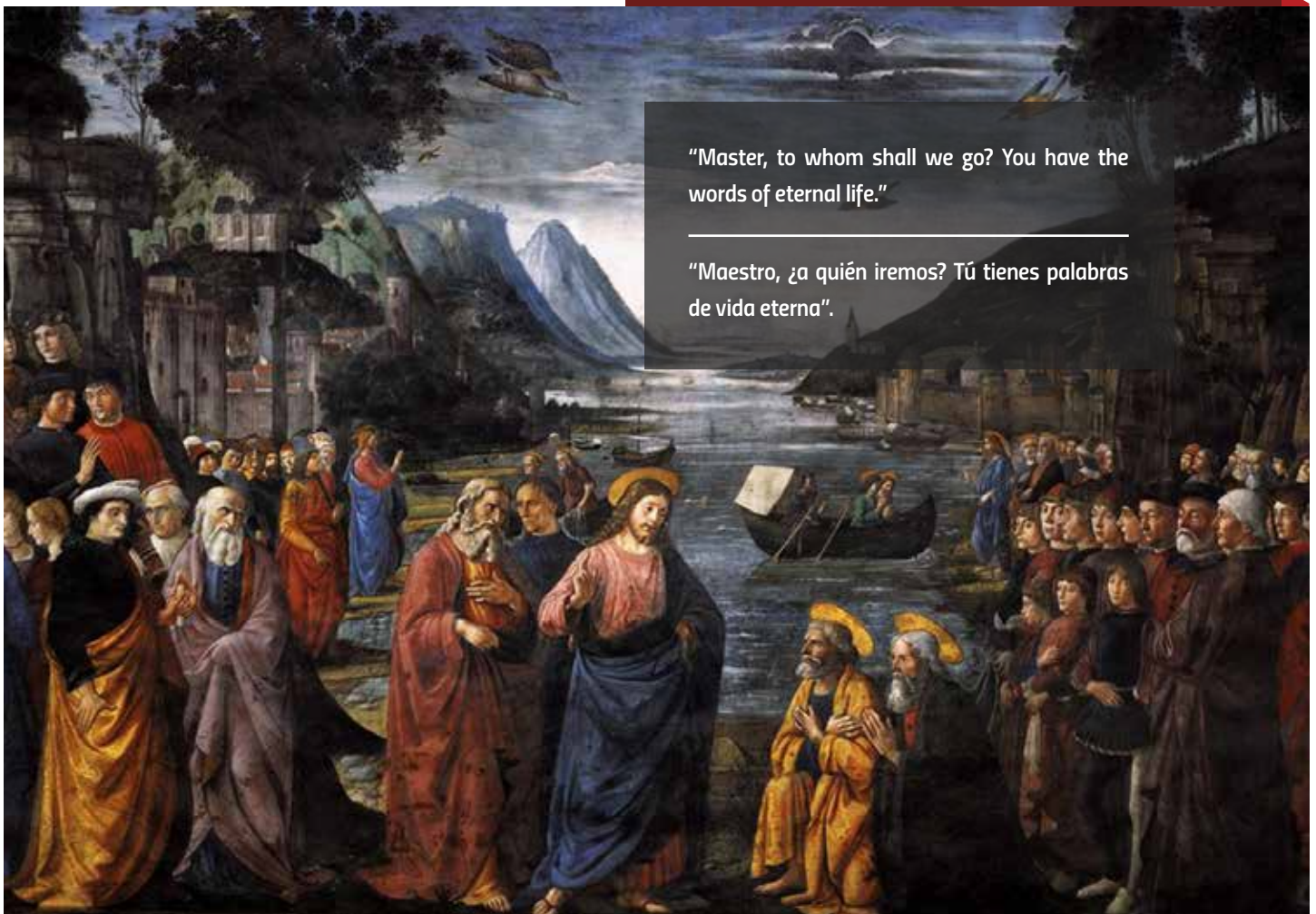

THE WISDOM OF ST. ELIZABETH SETON

Seton was described as a charming and cultured lady. Her connections to New York society and the accompanying social pressures to leave the new life she had created for herself did not deter her from embracing her religious vocation and charitable mission. The greatest difficulties she faced were actually internal, stemming from misunderstandings, interpersonal conflicts and the deaths of two daughters, other loved ones, and young sisters in the community. She died on January 4, 1821, at the age of 46. Today, her remains are entombed in the National Shrine of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton in Emmitsburg, Maryland.

DEL OBISPO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, Fieles de la Di3cesis de Venice

A los Obispos y Sacerdotes se les confa el cuidado espiritual y la protecci3n de su reba3o, especialmente de los menores y adultos vulnerables. Como pastores, actúan en nombre de Cristo y Su Iglesia, y por eso siempre deben prestar atenci3n a la Advertencia del Pastor: "Quien haga que uno de estos peque3os que cree en mí peque, sería mejor para él si se le colgara al cuello una gran piedra de molino y se le arrojara al mar" (Marcos 9:42).

Como su Obispo, entiendo la grave responsabilidad moral que me ha sido confiada y que es mi deber proteger a los fieles del peligro. Recientes revelaciones de un profundo mal me causan una profunda angustia. El abuso sexual infligido a tantos hijos e hijas de la Iglesia es pecaminoso y criminal. Algunos Jerarcas de la Iglesia no hicieron lo que estaban obligados a hacer. Si bien todos somos pecadores, la atroz historia de abuso y encubrimiento, como la detallada por el Gran Jurado en Pensilvania es absolutamente atroz y profundamente perturbador.

Las nuevas revelaciones de abuso me dejan triste. Es doloroso que Oficiales de la Iglesia hayan contribuido a una cultura que justific3 f3cilmente el comportamiento depredador. Ninguna palabra puede expresar adecuadamente mi contrici3n por los pecados horribles cometidos. Deseo ofrecer mis sinceras disculpas a las v3ctimas y sus familias por lo que les hicieron los ministros de Iglesia. Es mi compromiso hacer penitencia personal en reparaci3n por estos graves pecados y alentar al clero y a los fieles de la Di3cesis a unirse a mí en esta penitencia.

Las revelaciones recientes son realmente preocupantes, pero me siento en deuda con las v3ctimas que valientemente arrojaron la luz de la verdad sobre las horribles fechorías y la indiferencia ante la protesta de los abusados. Es importante expresar estima a aquellos que sobrevivieron a la conducta pecaminosa y criminal de Sacerdotes y Obispos. Violando la confianza sagrada de su ministerio, el clero se aprovech3 de los inocentes y vulnerables que buscaban y que tenían derecho a asistencia espiritual. Este es el momento para que estos fracasos sean admitidos y remediados.

En la p3gina web diocesana (www.dioceseofvenice.org) publicamos una declaraci3n informando al p3blico sobre sacerdotes nombrados en el informe del Gran Jurado de Pensilvania que han tenido alg3n lazo con la Di3cesis de Venice. Espero que esta transparencia demuestre mi convicci3n de que el liderazgo de la Iglesia debe estar atenta a la protecci3n de los menores y evitar que las mismas fallas se repitan. En este asunto, no hay lugar para intereses institucionales. Como tu Pastor, es mi compromiso volver a comprometer a nuestra Di3cesis con esfuerzos en3rgicos para erradicar el abuso sexual y fomentar a3n m3s una cultura de seguridad. Los obispos deben demostrar su disposici3n a dar la bienvenida a las v3ctimas de abuso sexual con compasi3n, escuchar las acusaciones con franqueza y tratar eficazmente con aquellos, independientemente de su rango o posici3n, que se hayan cometido abuso de cualquier tipo.

Mi oraci3n es que las revelaciones recientes arrojen la luz de la verdad sobre estos asuntos preocupantes y muestren a la Iglesia y a sus líderes los pasos que deben tomarse para recuperar la confianza de los fieles.

María Madre de la Iglesia, reforma los corazones de aquellos que dirigen tu Iglesia. Haznos m3s atentos a los gritos de aquellos que sufren abusos y nos ayudan a mostrar verdadera contrici3n por nuestros fracasos. Dale la comodidad de tu cuidado maternal a todos los que han sido afectados por el abuso sexual.

Dear Brother and Sisters, Faithful of the Diocese of Venice,

Bishops and Priests are entrusted with the spiritual care and protection of their flock, particularly of minors and vulnerable adults. As Pastors, they act in the name of Christ and His Church, and so must always heed the Good Shepherd's warning: *"Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were hung round his neck and he were thrown into the sea"* (Mark 9:42).

As your Bishop, I understand the grave moral responsibility with which I have been entrusted and that it is my duty to protect the faithful from harm. Recent revelations of profound evil cause me deep distress. The sexual abuse inflicted on so many sons and daughters of the Church is sinful and criminal. Some Church Hierarchy failed to do as they were obligated to do. While we are all sinners, the heinous history of abuse and coverup, such as that detailed by the Grand Jury in Pennsylvania, is utterly appalling and deeply disturbing.

The new disclosures of abuse leave me sorrowful. It is painful that Church Officials contributed to a culture that too easily excused predatory behavior. No words can adequately express my contrition for the horrible sins committed. I wish to offer victims and their families my sincere apology for what was done to them by ministers of the Church. It is my commitment to do personal penance in reparation for these grave sins and to encourage the clergy and faithful of the Diocese to join with me in this penance.


Recent revelations are indeed troubling, yet I feel indebted to the victims who courageously shed the light of truth on the horrific misdeeds and the indifference to the outcry of those abused. It is important to express abiding esteem to those who survived the sinful and criminal conduct of Priests and Bishops. Violating the sacred trust of their ministry, clergy took advantage of the innocent and the vulnerable who sought out and had a right to spiritual care. It is the time for these failures to be admitted and remedied.

On the diocesan website (www.dioceseofvenice.org) there is posted a statement informing the public about those priests named in the Pennsylvania Grand Jury Report who have had some ties to the Diocese of Venice. It is hoped this transparency will demonstrate my conviction that Church leadership must be vigilant in protecting minors and prevent the same failures from being repeated. In this matter, there is no room for institutional interests. As your Shepherd, it is my pledge to recommit our Diocese to the vigorous efforts to eradicate sexual abuse and further foster a culture of safety. Bishops must demonstrate a willingness to welcome victims of sexual abuse with compassion, hear their allegations with openness and deal effectively with those — regardless of rank or position — who committed abuse of any kind.

My prayer is that recent revelations will shed the light of truth on these troubling matters and show Church leaders the steps that need to be taken to regain the trust of the faithful.

Mary Mother of the Church, reform the hearts of those who lead your Church. Make us more attentive to the cries of those who suffer abuse and help us show true contrition for our failures. Bring the comfort of your maternal care to all who have been impacted by sexual abuse.
