



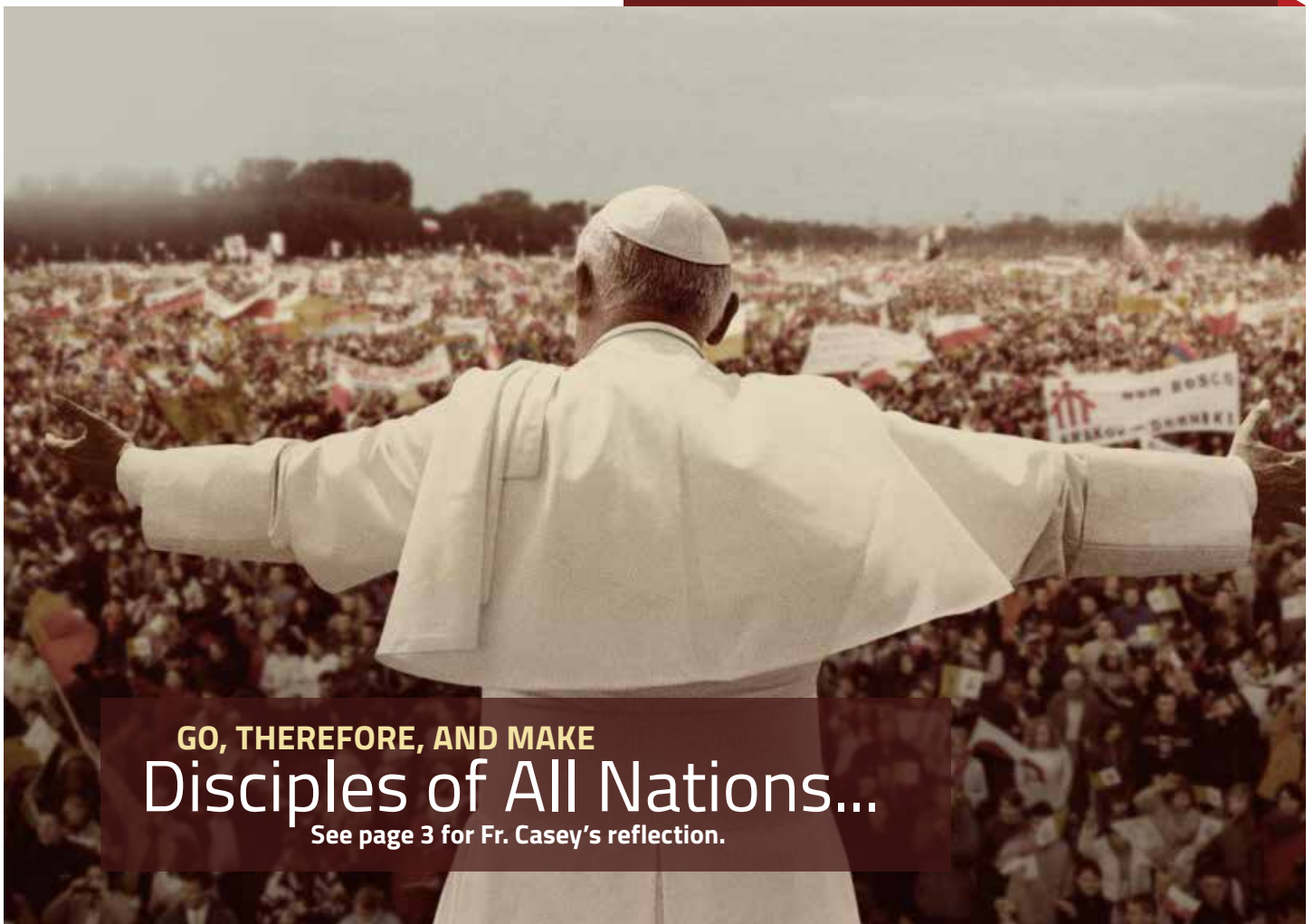

# GO, THEREFORE AND MAKE DISCIPLES

The Church—that is to say, the Catholic Church, the Universal members of the Body of Christ, must be focused on her mission. Her mission is simple: “Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit” (Matthew 28:19). We, as a Church, are in the disciple making business. We have a duty, a solemn obligation to “Go out!” and proclaim the Gospel to the world. We are not a social club, we are not just an organization focused on charity, we are not a community organization. We are members of the Church of Jesus Christ. As members of the Body of Christ, we must be committed to his vision of disciple-making.

As Pope Francis observed: “When the Church does not go out of herself to evangelize, she becomes self-referential; she grows ill (like the stooped woman in the Gospel). The evils which appear throughout history in Church institutions are rooted in this self-referentiality – a kind of theological narcissism.” (Evangelium Nutiandi) For so long, many of us may have brought into the erroneous notion that evangelization is the job of missionaries, of religious, or of priests. This is false. It is the job of all to evangelize—to explicitly evangelize. Saying “I evangelize with my life” is not enough. Each and every Christian is called to share in the work of leading others to explicit faith in Christ. If a Christian is not engaged actively and daily in the mission of evangelization, he or she is not in the will of God and is committing a grave sin of omission.

As St. John Paul II reminded the Church: “No believer in Christ, no institution of the Church can avoid this supreme duty: to proclaim Christ to all peoples.” This is what we are about. This means, that I as a Catholic have three tasks:

1. To know my Catholic faith
2. To Live my Catholic faith
3. To Share my Catholic faith

It’s time to begin to consider: How well do I know Sacred Scripture and the teachings of the Church? How does my life reflect the teachings of Jesus and his Church? How am I actively sharing my faith with others? We want to help you. Beginning in Lent, we will start a 12-week program of Bible Study. We will begin with a parish Mission, from March 12-14 and provide other opportunities to grow in our faith. If every one of us as members of the St. Elizabeth Seton Family is able, let’s begin to pray about what each of us can be doing to advance the Kingdom of God. Here I provide the words of St. John Paul II that inspired me as a youth:

“Do not be afraid to go out on the streets and into public places, like the first Apostles who preached Christ and the Good News of salvation in the squares of cities, towns and villages. This is no time to be ashamed of the Gospel (Cfr. Rom 1,16). It is the time to preach it from the rooftops (Cfr. Mat 10,27). Do not be afraid to break out of comfortable and routine modes of living, in order to take up the challenge of making Christ known in the modern ‘metropolis’. It is you who must ‘go out into the byroads’ (Matthew 22:9) and invite everyone you meet to the banquet which God has prepared for his people. The Gospel must not be kept hidden because of fear or indifference. It was never meant to be hidden away in private. It has to be put on a stand so that people may see its light and give praise to our heavenly Father.”

There are empty spaces in our pews. Let’s fill them.

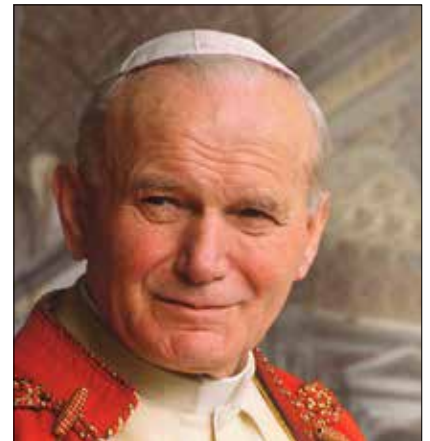

# VAYAN PUES Y HAGAN DISCÍPULOS

La Iglesia, es decir la Iglesia Católica, los miembros universales del Cuerpo de Cristo, deben centrarse en su misión. Su misión es simple: “Vayan pues y hagan discípulos a todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo”. (Mateo 28:19). Nosotros como Iglesia, estamos en el negocio de hacer discípulos. Tenemos el deber, la solemne obligación de “¡Salir!” Y proclamar el Evangelio al mundo. No somos un club social, no somos solo una organización centrada en la caridad, no somos una organización comunitaria. Somos miembros de la Iglesia de Jesucristo. Como miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo debemos estar comprometidos con su visión de hacer discípulos.

Como observó el Papa Francisco: “Cuando la Iglesia no sale de sí misma para evangelizar, se vuelve autorreferencial; ella se enferma (como la mujer encorvada en el Evangelio). Los males que aparecen a lo largo de la historia en las instituciones de la Iglesia están arraigados en esta auto referencialidad, una especie de narcisismo teológico”. (Evangelii Nutiandi). Durante tanto tiempo, muchos de nosotros hemos llegado a la idea errónea de que la evangelización es tarea de los misioneros, los religiosos, o los sacerdotes. Esto es falso. El trabajo de todos es evangelizar, evangelizar explícitamente. Decir “evangelizo con mi vida” no es suficiente. Todos y cada uno de los cristianos están llamados a compartir la obra de guiar a otros a la fe explícita en Cristo. Si un cristiano no está comprometido activamente y diariamente en la misión de la evangelización, él o ella no está en la voluntad de Dios y está cometiendo un grave pecado de omisión.



Como San Juan Pablo II le recordó a la Iglesia: “Ningún creyente en Cristo, ninguna institución de la Iglesia puede evitar este deber supremo: proclamar a Cristo a todos los pueblos”. De esto se trata. Esto significa, que yo como católico tengo tres tareas:

1. Conocer mi fe católica.
2. Vivir mi fe católica.
3. Compartir mi fe católica.

Es hora de comenzar a considerar: ¿Qué tan bien conozco la Sagrada Escritura y las enseñanzas de la Iglesia? ¿Cómo refleja mi vida las enseñanzas de Jesús y su Iglesia? ¿Cómo estoy compartiendo activamente mi fe con los demás? Queremos ayudarle. A partir de la Cuaresma, comenzaremos un programa de Estudio Bíblico de 12 semanas. Comenzaremos con una misión parroquial, del 12 al 14 de marzo y ofreceremos otras oportunidades para crecer en nuestra fe. Cada uno de nosotros como miembros de la familia St. Elizabeth Seton para comenzar a orar acerca de lo que podemos hacer para avanzar en el Reino de Dios. Aquí proporciono las palabras de San Juan Pablo II que me inspiraron en mi juventud:

“No tenga miedo de salir a las calles y a lugares públicos, como los primeros apóstoles que predicaron a Cristo y las buenas nuevas de la salvación en las plazas de ciudades, pueblos y aldeas. No es el momento de avergonzarse del Evangelio (Cfr. Rom 1.16). Es el momento de predicarlo desde los tejados (Cfr. Matth. 10,27). No tenga miedo de salir de los modos de vida cómodos y rutinarios, a fin de asumir el desafío de dar a conocer a Cristo en la moderna “metrópolis”. Es usted quien debe “salir a los caminos” (Mateo 22: 9) e invitar a todos los que se encuentren al banquete que Dios ha preparado para su pueblo. El Evangelio no debe mantenerse oculto por miedo o indiferencia. Nunca fue pensado para ser escondido en privado. Debe ponerse de pie para que la gente pueda ver su luz y alabar a nuestro Padre celestial “. Hay espacios vacíos en nuestros bancos. Vamos a llenarlos.
