



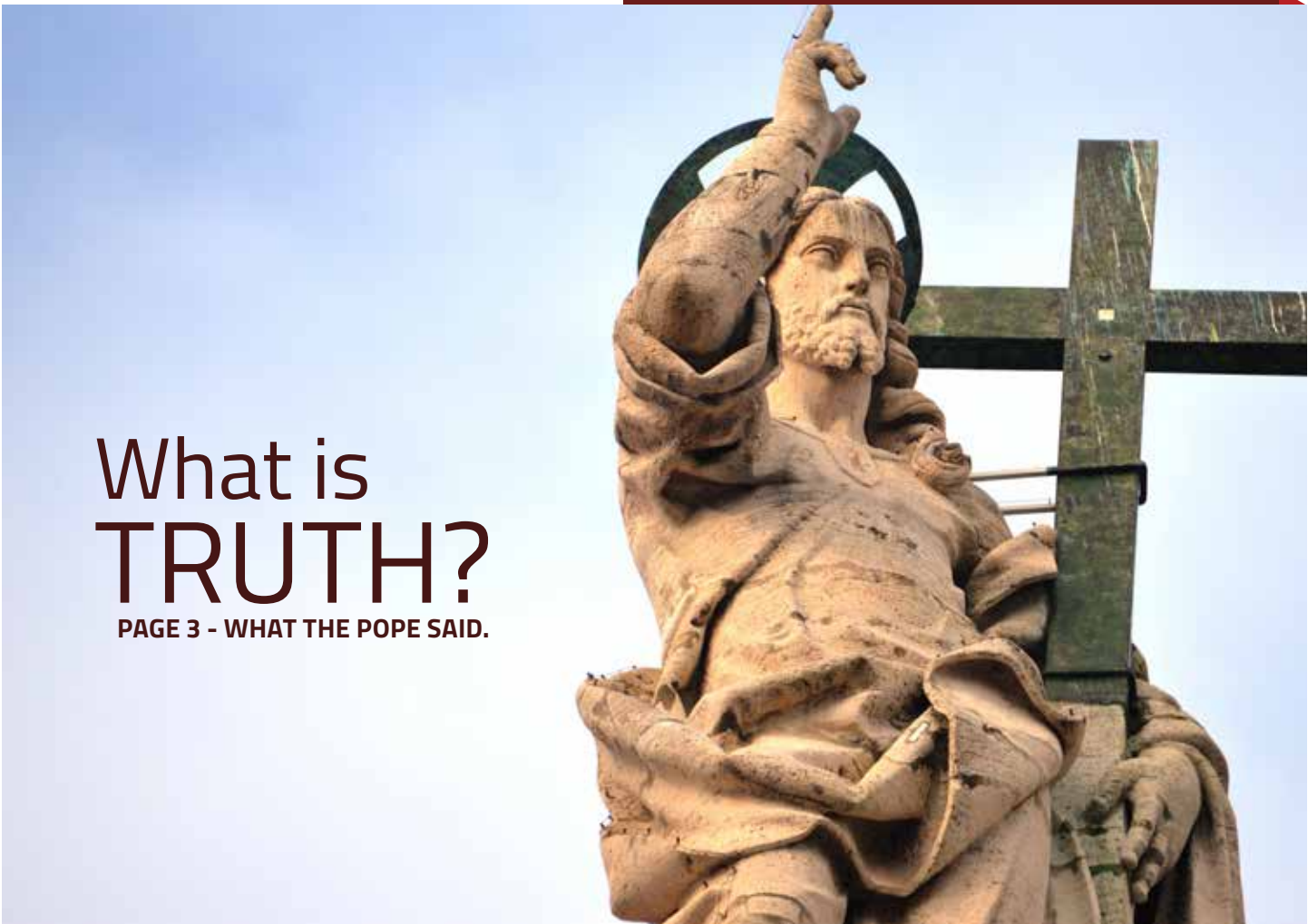

“WHAT IS TRUTH?”

“What is Truth?” is a question that was posed to Jesus as he stood trial before Pontius Pilate. (Jn 18:38) This is a question that is posed by the world. Jesus tells us that HE is this Truth (Jn 14:6, 18:37), and that the Truth will make us free (Jn 8:32). The world likes to tell us that there is no truth, that truth is relative to each person. As Josef Ratzinger said when he addressed the conclave that would elect him Pope: “We are building a dictatorship of relativism that does not recognize anything as definitive and whose ultimate goal consists solely of one’s own ego and desires.” This ‘dictatorship of relativism’ is the way of the world. Anyone who claims to know objective truth is labeled as a bigot or a fundamentalist. It is a crime in the world to speak truth, because truth can make people uncomfortable. “We, however, have a different goal: the Son of God, the true man. He is the measure of true humanism. An ‘adult’ faith is not a faith that follows the trends of fashion and the latest novelty; a mature adult faith is deeply rooted in friendship with Christ. It is this friendship that opens us up to all that is good and gives us a criterion by which to distinguish the true from the false, and deceit from truth.”



Christ reminds us that faith—trust in him is not blinding, but rather enlightening and helps us to know truth. Pope Francis has also spoken several times about the errors of relativism. Once when in Korea, he observed that “The spirit of the world,” he said, tempts us with “the deceptive light of relativism, which obscures the splendor of truth and, shaking the earth beneath our feet, pushes us toward the shifting sands of confusion and despair.” The Popes of modernity have been to us what the prophet Jeremiah was to his people, as he reminds us in the first reading today “Cursed is the one who trusts in human beings, who seeks his strength in flesh...Blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD.” The relativism of the world undermines human dignity, as it makes me the center of my own universe, the creator and arbiter of my own truth. Seeking and knowing the truth, which doesn’t blind, but enlightens, does not enslave, but make us free, requires me to open my heart to be humble. The “dictatorship” of relativism is combated with humility, charity, and the clarity that comes from Truth.

“¿QUÉ ES LA VERDAD?”

“¿Qué es la verdad?” Es una pregunta que se le hizo a Jesús cuando fue juzgado ante Poncio Pilato. (Jn 18:38) Esta es una pregunta que plantea el mundo. Jesús nos dice que ÉL es esta Verdad (Jn 14: 6, 18:37) y que la Verdad nos hará libres (Jn 8:32). Al mundo le gusta decirnos que no hay verdad, que la verdad es relativa a cada persona. Como dijo Josef Ratzinger cuando se dirigió al cónclave que lo elegiría Papa: “Estamos construyendo una dictadura del relativismo que no reconoce nada como definitivo y cuyo objetivo final consiste únicamente en el propio ego y los deseos”. Esta “dictadura del relativismo” Es el camino del mundo. Cualquiera que afirme conocer la verdad objetiva está etiquetado como intolerante o fundamentalista. Es un crimen en el mundo hablar la verdad, porque la verdad puede hacer que las personas se sientan incómodas. “Nosotros, sin embargo, tenemos una meta diferente: el Hijo de Dios, el verdadero hombre. Él es la medida del verdadero humanismo. Una fe “adulta” no es una fe que sigue las tendencias de la moda y la última novedad; una fe adulta madura está profundamente arraigada en la amistad con Cristo. “Es esta amistad la que nos abre a todo lo que es bueno y nos da un criterio para distinguir lo verdadero de lo falso y el engaño de la verdad”.



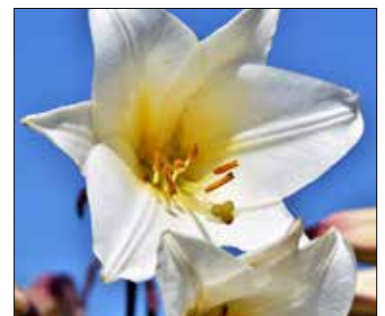
Cristo nos recuerda que la fe: confiar en él no es cegarnos, sino más bien ilumina y nos ayuda a conocer la verdad. El Papa Francisco también ha hablado varias veces sobre los errores del relativismo. Una vez en Corea, observó que “el espíritu del mundo”, dijo, nos tienta con

“la luz engañosa del relativismo, que oculta el esplendor de la verdad y sacudiendo la tierra bajo nuestros pies, nos empuja hacia las arenas movedizas de confusión y desesperación”. Los Papas de la modernidad han sido para nosotros lo que el profeta Jeremías fue para su pueblo, como nos recuerda en la primera lectura de hoy “Maldito es el que confía en los seres humanos, que busca su fuerza en la carne ... Bienaventurado el que confía en el SEÑOR”. El relativismo del mundo carcome la dignidad humana, ya que me convierte en el centro de mi propio universo, el creador y el árbitro de mi propia verdad. Buscar y conocer la verdad, que no ciega, sino que ilumina, no esclaviza, pero nos hace libres, requiere que abra mi corazón para ser humilde. La “dictadura” del relativismo se combate con humildad, caridad y la claridad que proviene de la verdad.
