

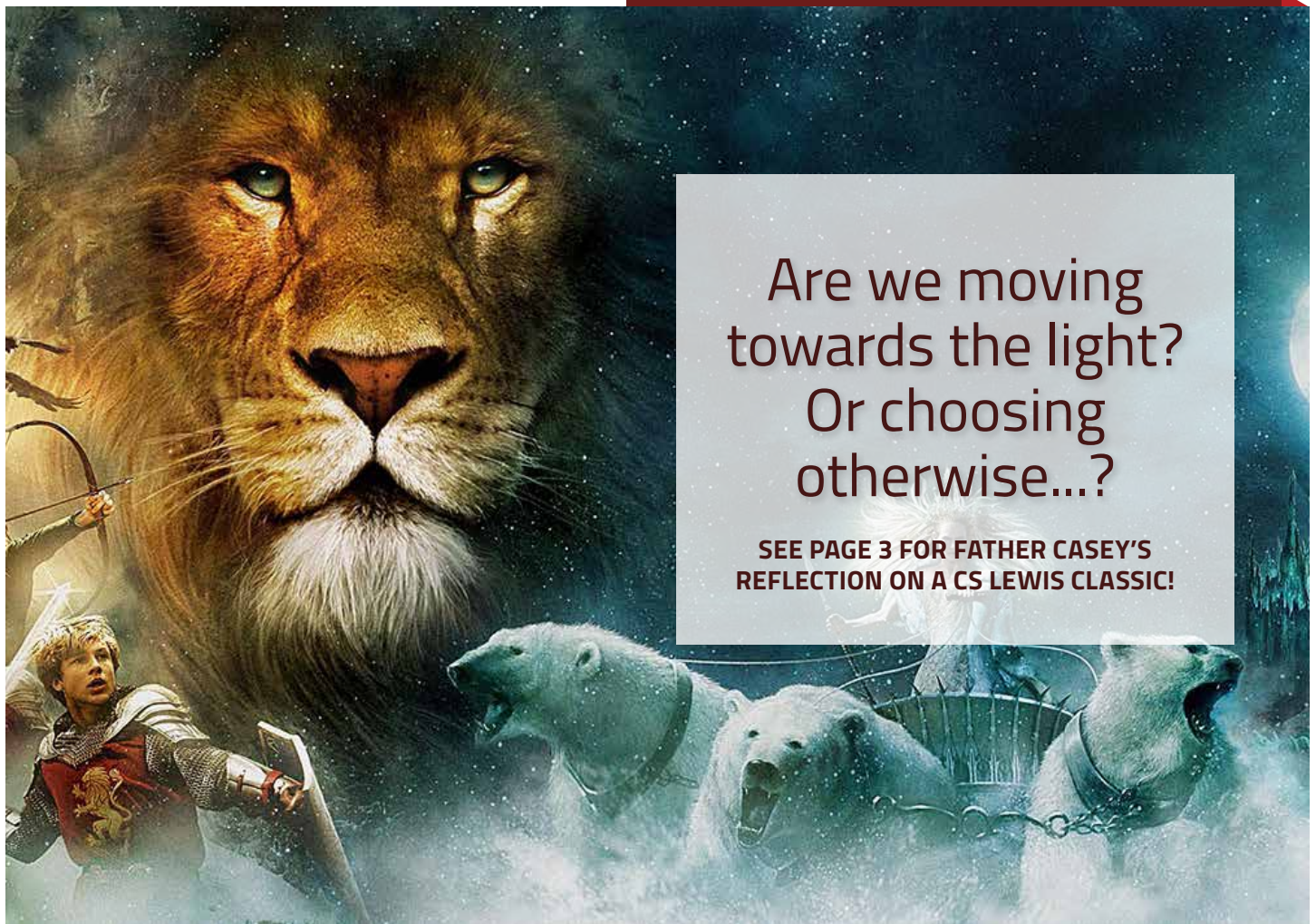

MOVE TOWARD THE LIGHT.

"Lucy felt a little frightened, but she felt very inquisitive and excited as well. She looked back over her shoulder and there, between the dark tree-trunks, she could still see the open doorway of the wardrobe and even catch a glimpse of the empty room from which she had set out. (She had, of course, left the door open, for she knew that it is a very silly thing to shut oneself into a wardrobe.) It seemed to be still daylight there. "I can always get back if anything goes wrong," thought Lucy. She began to walk forward, crunch-crunch over the snow and through the wood toward the other light."

This passage from *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe* by C.S. Lewis depicts a little girl who finds herself in one moment playing hide-and-seek in a wardrobe, and in the next standing in the middle of a strange new world. This story is a parallel to what life is like when we decide to follow Jesus. Often, our journey with the Lord can take us places where we feel both apprehensive and intrigued at the same time. In one moment, the Lord is offering us words of comfort, "Blessed are you who weep" (Lk 6:21) and in the next, he is inviting us into a radical and risky love: "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you." (Lk 6:27-28) If you can imagine the disciples who were listening to Jesus, they may feel that they were the victims of a bait-and-switch. But they, as we are called to, would soon realize that while the demands of the Gospel are high, that we never walk it alone. It's not easy to love our enemies. But Jesus doesn't just tell us. He shows us by his cross. Today we may find ourselves like little Lucy, standing between two worlds and deciding to which we belong. Though we may be a little overwhelmed, let's resolve to move more toward the light. -Fr. Casey



THE GOLDEN RULE GOSPEL OF LUKE

"Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven." --- Luke 6:37

Today's gospel delivers a powerful message from Christ on acceptance, forgiveness, judging, and compassion as well as a guide on how we treat those we encounter in our daily lives. Our efforts at SVdP is to be more Christ-like in our work with the poor. We simply seek to help without prejudice or unfairness. We seek to be moral, kind, respectful and understanding regardless of the beliefs or repute of those we serve.

We can learn much from this scripture, not only to help those we come across, but to help us to be more Christ-like on our journey of faith.

Lucy se sintió un poco asustada, pero también se sintió muy inquisitiva y emocionada. Miró por encima del hombro y allí, entre los troncos oscuros de los árboles, todavía podía ver la puerta abierta del armario e incluso echar un vistazo a la habitación vacía de la que había salido. (Naturalmente había dejado la puerta abierta, porque sabía que era una tontería encerrarse en un armario). Parecía que todavía había luz de día allí. "Siempre puedo volver si algo sale mal", pensó Lucy. Comenzó a caminar hacia delante, crujiendo sobre la nieve y atravesando la madera hacia la otra luz.

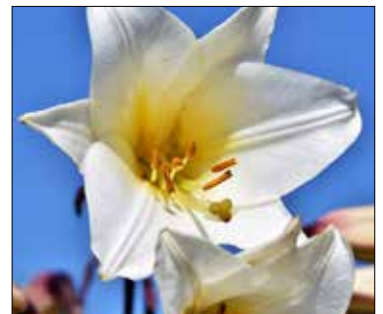
Este pasaje de El león, la bruja y el armario de C.S. Lewis representa a una niña pequeña que se encuentra en un momento jugando a las escondidas en un armario y en la siguiente escena, en medio de un extraño mundo nuevo. Esta historia es paralela a cómo es la vida cuando decidimos seguir a Jesús. A menudo, nuestro viaje con el Señor puede llevarnos a lugares donde nos sentimos aprensivos e intrigados al mismo tiempo. En un momento, el Señor nos ofrece palabras de consuelo: "Bienaventurados los que lloran" (Lc 6, 21) y en el siguiente, nos invita a un amor radical y arriesgado: "Ama a tus enemigos, haz el bien de los que te odian, bendice a los que te maldicen, ora por los que te maltratan" (Lc 6, 27-28). Si puedes imaginar a los discípulos que escuchaban a Jesús, ellos quizá sintieron que fueron víctimas de propaganda. Sin embargo ellos, como estamos llamados a hacerlo todos, pronto se darían cuenta de que, si bien las demandas del Evangelio son elevadas, nunca caminamos solos. No es fácil amar a nuestros enemigos, pero Jesús no solo nos lo dice, El nos lo demuestra con su cruz. Hoy podemos encontrarnos como la pequeña Lucy, parados entre dos mundos sin saber a cual pertenecemos. Aunque podemos estar un poco abrumados, resolvamos avanzar más hacia la luz.
