# “CHEAP GRACE”

Firstly, I would like to offer a congratulations to all of our children who received First Holy Communion, along with their parents. We are all so very proud of you!

As for my thoughts and reflections this week, I have a lengthy quote I would like to share. It is from one of my favorite non-Catholic authors, Fredrick Bonhoeffer a Lutheran Pastor who was martyred at the hands of the Nazis during World War II. Bonhoeffer frequently refers to something he calls “cheap grace”. Rather than try to explain this quote, I will share it verbatim. It was very convicting to me as I re-read it. I invite all to take it to prayer:

“Cheap grace means grace sold on the market like cheapjacks’ wares. The sacraments, the forgiveness of sin, and the consolations of religion are thrown away at cut prices. Grace is represented as the Church’s inexhaustible treasury, from which she showers blessings with generous hands, without asking questions or fixing limits. Grace without price; grace without cost! The essence of grace, we suppose, is that the account has been paid in advance; and, because it has been paid, everything can be had for nothing. Since the cost was infinite, the possibilities of using and spending it are infinite. What would grace be if it were not cheap?...

Cheap grace is the preaching of forgiveness without requiring repentance, baptism without church discipline, Communion without confession, absolution without personal confession. Cheap grace is grace without discipleship, grace without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ, living and incarnate.

Costly grace is the treasure hidden in the field; for the sake of it a man will go and sell all that he has. It is the pearl of great price to buy which the merchant will sell all his goods. It is the kingly rule of Christ, for whose sake a man will pluck out the eye which causes him to stumble; it is the call of Jesus Christ at which the disciple leaves his nets and follows him.

Costly grace is the gospel which must be sought again and again, the gift which must be asked for, the door at which a man must knock.

Such grace is costly because it calls us to follow, and it is grace because it calls us to follow Jesus Christ. It is costly because it costs a man his life, and it is grace because it gives a man the only true life. It is costly because it condemns sin, and grace because it justifies the sinner. Above all, it is costly because it cost God the life of his Son: “ye were bought at a price,” and what has cost God much cannot be cheap for us. Above all, it is grace because God did not reckon his Son too dear a price to pay for our life, but delivered him up for us. Costly grace is the Incarnation of God.”

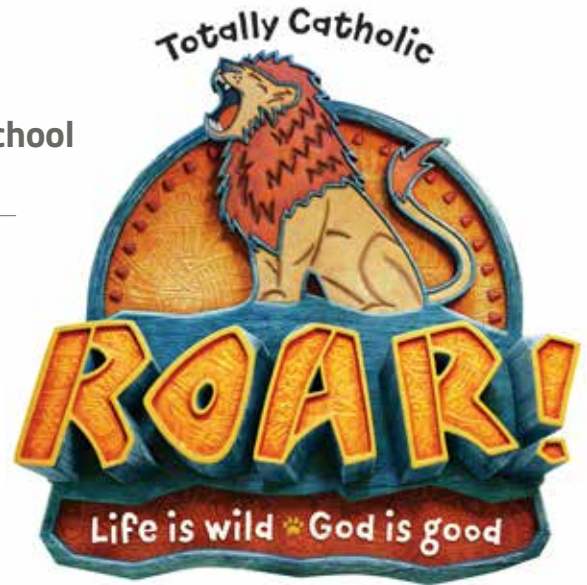

## DR. BERNARD NATHANSON ON WHY HE STOPPED DOING ABORTIONS

"I ran the largest abortion clinic in the world for 2 years. I had no conflicts whatsoever at the time I was doing the abortions. I changed my mind because the new scientific data which we were getting from advanced technology persuaded me that we could not indiscriminately continue to slaughter what was demonstrably a human being."

Interview with Bernard Nathanson, M.D., 1986 (the most famous abortionist in history)

"In its seventh week [the unborn baby] bears the familiar external features and all the internal organs of the adult...The brain in configuration is already like the adult brain and sends out impulses that coordinate the functions of other organs...The heart beats sturdily. The stomach produces digestive juices. The liver manufactures blood cells and the kidneys begin to function by extracting uric acid from the child's blood...The muscles of the arms and body can already be set in motion. After the eighth week... everything is already present that will be found in the full-term baby."

# “GRACIA BARATA”

En primer lugar, me gustaría felicitar a todos nuestros niños que recibieron la Primera Comunión junto con sus padres. ¡Estamos todos muy orgullosos de ustedes!

En cuanto a mis pensamientos y reflexiones de esta semana, tengo una larga cita que me gustaría compartir. Es de uno de mis autores favoritos no Católicos, Fredrick Bonhoeffer, un pastor luterano que fue martirizado a manos de los nazis durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial. Bonhoeffer con frecuencia se refiere a algo que él llama “gracia barata”. En lugar de tratar de explicar esta cita, la compartiré textualmente. Fue muy convincente para mí cuando lo releí. Invito a todos a llevarlo a la oración:

“Gracia barata significa gracia vendida en el mercado como productos de mercaderes turcos”. Los Sacramentos, el perdón de los pecados y el consuelo de la religión se desechan a precios reducidos o rebajas. La gracia está representada como el tesoro inagotable de la Iglesia, del cual derrama bendiciones con manos generosas, sin hacer preguntas ni fijar límites. ¡Gracia sin precio! ¡Gracia sin costo! La esencia de la gracia, suponemos, es que la cuenta se ha pagado por adelantado, y, como se ha pagado, todo se puede tener por nada. Como el costo era infinito, las posibilidades de usarlo y gastarlo son infinitas. ¿Qué gracia sería si no fuera barato? ...

La gracia barata es la predicación del perdón sin requerir el arrepentimiento, el bautismo sin disciplina de la Iglesia, la Comunión sin Confesión, la Absolución sin Confesión personal. La gracia barata es gracia sin discipulado, gracia sin cruz, gracia sin Jesucristo, vivo y encarnado.

La gracia costosa es el tesoro escondido en el campo, para comprarlo, un hombre irá y venderá todo lo que tiene. Es la perla de gran precio por la que el comerciante venderá todos sus bienes para comprarla. Es el gobierno real de Cristo, por cuyo bien un hombre se arrancará el ojo que le hace tropezar; es el llamado de Jesucristo por el cual el discípulo deja sus redes y lo sigue.

La gracia costosa es el Evangelio que debe buscarse una y otra vez, es el don que debe pedirse, es la puerta a la que el hombre debe tocar.

Tal gracia es costosa porque nos llama a seguir, y es gracia porque nos llama a seguir a Jesucristo. Es costosa porque le cuesta a un hombre su vida, y es gracia porque le da al hombre la única vida verdadera. Es costosa porque condena el pecado y es gracia porque justifica al pecador. Sobre todo, es costosa porque le costó a Dios la vida de su Hijo: “fuiste comprado a un precio”, y lo que le ha costado tanto a Dios no puede ser barato para nosotros. Sobre todo, es gracia porque Dios no estimó a su Hijo un precio demasiado caro para pagar por nuestra vida, sino que lo entregó por nosotros. “La gracia costosa es la Encarnación de Dios”.
