





PROFESSING THE TRINITY

As Catholics we are familiar with the profession of faith, the Nicene Creed, which we pray every Sunday at the Holy Mass. Most of us also at some point learned the Apostle's creed which, is an option to be used at Mass, however we are most familiar with it as part of the Rosary. Throughout the history of the Church, there have been a number of creeds or professions of faith which attempt to summarize what God has revealed to us about himself. In the traditional liturgy of the Church, on this Trinity Sunday, there was a custom of professing the Athanasian Creed, an ancient profession of faith summarizing what we believe about the most Holy Trinity. As part of our prayer the week, let's spend some time praying with these profound statements of faith, even though we may not understand them fully. The Trinity is a mystery of God's love revealed to us and can never be captured perfectly in any statement. Like any mystery, it requires reflection and prayer to give us moments of access to its depths, so let us take this ancient creed to prayer this week, reflecting on Our God who is Love and how he has revealed himself to us:

Whosoever will be saved, before all things it is necessary that he hold the Catholic Faith. Which Faith except everyone do keep whole and undefiled, without doubt he shall perish everlastingly. And the Catholic Faith is this, that we worship one God in Trinity and Trinity in Unity. Neither confounding the Persons, nor dividing the Substance. For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Spirit. But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit is all One, the Glory Equal, the Majesty Co-Eternal. Such as the Father is, such is the Son, and such is the Holy Spirit. The Father Uncreated, the Son Uncreated, and the Holy Spirit Uncreated. The Father Incomprehensible, the Son Incomprehensible, and the Holy Spirit Incomprehensible.



The Father Eternal, the Son Eternal, and the Holy Spirit Eternal and yet they are not Three Eternals but One Eternal. As also there are not Three Uncreated, nor Three Incomprehensibles, but One Uncreated, and One Incomprehensible. So likewise the Father is Almighty, the Son Almighty, and the Holy Spirit Almighty. And yet they are not Three Almighties but One Almighty.

So the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God. And yet they are not Three Gods, but One God. So likewise the Father is Lord, the Son Lord, and the Holy Spirit Lord. And yet not Three Lords but One Lord. For, like as we are compelled by the Christian verity to acknowledge every Person by Himself to be God and Lord, so are we forbidden by the Catholic Religion to say, there be Three Gods or Three Lords. The Father is made of none, neither created, nor begotten. The Son is of the Father alone; not made, nor created, but begotten. The Holy Spirit is of the Father, and of the Son neither made, nor created, nor begotten, but proceeding.

So there is One Father, not Three Fathers; one Son, not Three Sons; One Holy Spirit, not Three Holy Spirits. And in this Trinity none is before or after the other, None is greater or less than Another, but the whole Three Persons are Co-eternal together, and Co-equal. So that in all things, as is aforesaid, the Unity in Trinity, and the Trinity in Unity, is to be worshiped. He therefore that will be saved, must thus think of the Trinity.



SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD

Como católicos estamos familiarizados con la profesión de fe, el Credo de Nicea, que oramos todos los domingos en la Santa Misa. La mayoría de nosotros también aprendimos en algún momento el credo de los Apóstoles, que es una opción para ser usado en la Misa, sin embargo, estamos Más familiarizados con él como parte del rosario. A lo largo de la historia de la Iglesia, ha habido varios credos o profesiones de fe que intentan resumir lo que Dios nos ha revelado acerca de sí mismo. En la liturgia tradicional de la Iglesia, en este domingo de la Trinidad, existía la costumbre de profesar el Credo de Atanasio, una antigua profesión de fe que resume lo que creemos acerca de la Santísima Trinidad. Como parte de nuestra oración de la semana, dediquemos un tiempo a orar con estas profundas declaraciones de fe, aunque no las entendamos completamente. La Trinidad es un misterio del amor de Dios que nos fue revelado y nunca puede ser capturado perfectamente en ninguna declaración. Como todo misterio, requiere reflexión y oración para darnos momentos de acceso a sus profundidades, así que llevemos este antiguo credo a la oración de esta semana, reflexionando sobre Nuestro Dios que es el Amor y cómo se ha revelado a nosotros mismos:



Todo el que quiera salvarse, ante todo es necesario que mantenga la fe católica; el que no la guarde íntegra e inviolada, sin duda perecerá para siempre. La fe católica es esta, que adoramos a un solo Dios en la Trinidad, y a la Trinidad en la unidad. Sin confundir las Personas ni separar la substancia. Porque una es la persona del Padre, otra la del Hijo y otra la del Espíritu Santo. El Padre y el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo tienen una sola divinidad, igual gloria y coeterna majestad. Cual el Padre, tal es el Hijo, y tal es el Espíritu Santo. El Padre increado, el Hijo increado y el Espíritu Santo. Incomprensible el Padre, incomprensible el Hijo, incomprensible el Espíritu Santo. Eterno el Padre, eterno el Hijo, eterno el Espíritu Santo, y, sin embargo, no son tres eternos, sino un solo eterno. Así como tampoco son tres increados ni tres incomprensibles, sino un solo increado y un solo incomprensible. Igualmente, el Padre es omnipotente, el Hijo es omnipotente, el Espíritu Santo es omnipotente; Sin embargo no son tres omnipotentes, sino un solo omnipotente.

Así el Padre es Dios, el Hijo es Dios y el Espíritu Santo es Dios. Sin embargo, no son tres dioses, sino un solo Dios. Así también el Padre es el Señor, el Hijo es el Señor y el Espíritu Santo es el Señor. Sin embargo, no son tres Señores, sino un solo Señor. Pues, así como la verdad cristiana nos compele a reconocer que cada Persona por sí misma es Dios y Señor, así mismo la religión católica nos prohíbe decir que hay tres dioses y tres señores. El Padre no fue hecho por nadie, ni creado, ni engendrado. El Hijo es solo del Padre, no hecho, ni creado, sino engendrado. El Espíritu Santo es del Padre y del Hijo, no fue hecho, ni creado, sino que procede de Ellos. Por lo tanto, hay un solo Padre, no tres Padres; un Hijo, no tres Hijos; un Espíritu Santo, no tres Espíritus Santos. En esta Trinidad ninguno va antes o después del otro, ninguno es mayor o menor que el otro, sino que las tres Personas son entre sí co-eternas e iguales; de modo que como se dijo antes, se debe adorar la Unidad en Trinidad y la Trinidad en Unidad. El que quiera pues salvarse, debe pensar así sobre la Trinidad.






