

CHRIST COMFORTS THE AFFLICTED AND AFFLICTS THE COMFORTABLE

It has been a long-held opinion of mine that effective preaching has a two-fold purpose: 1) To comfort the afflicted, and 2) To afflict the comfortable. It seems that this week, Jesus is doing more of the latter. Our Lord is clear that he requires our absolute devotion. He is not interested in those who would only follow him halfway. As we read in the book of Revelation, Jesus finds lukewarm-ness nauseating: "Because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of my mouth." (Rev 3:16). If that verse does not make us uncomfortable, then nothing will. And thank God for it.

Pope Benedict XVI reminds us in his work *Spe Salvi* that we are not called to comfort, we are called to something better, greatness. "Man was created for greatness—for God himself; he was created to be filled by God. But his heart is too small for the greatness to which it is destined. It must be stretched..." Sometimes stretching isn't comfortable. But moving out of our comfort zones enables God to do amazing things. When we step out, stereotypes are shattered, worldviews are inverted, and labels are destroyed. Today--right now, Jesus is calling you and me to step out, to leave behind what makes us comfortable and begin the journey of discipleship. This means we no longer just surround ourselves with people and things that make us feel good about ourselves, but rather, that we step out with a sense of adventure into the unknown. As we see from the bible, when disciples leave behind comfort in favor of following Jesus, they begin to do some crazy and amazing things like: Walk on the water (Mt. 14:29); Speak in a way that everyone understands, regardless of language (Acts 2:7-12); Heal the lame (Acts 3:6); and even raise the dead (Acts 20:10). God wants to do amazing things with us, he wants to end oppression, racial bigotry, feed the poor, educate the uneducated, love those who have been marginalized, and proclaim his Good News of salvation. All of this begins with us rejecting what makes us comfortable.



AFLIGIDO O COMODO?

La opinión mía desde hace mucho tiempo es que la predicación efectiva tiene un doble propósito: 1) consolar a los afligidos y 2) afligir a los cómodos. Parece que esta semana, Jesús está haciendo más de lo último. Nuestro Señor tiene claro que requiere nuestra devoción absoluta. No le interesan aquellos que solo lo seguirían hasta la mitad. Como leemos en el libro de Apocalipsis, Jesús encuentra nauseabunda la tibieza: "Porque eres tibio, y no frío ni caliente, te vomitaré de mi boca" (Apocalipsis 3:16). Si ese versículo no nos incomoda, nada lo hará. Y gracias a Dios por eso.

El Papa Benedicto XVI nos recuerda en su trabajo *Spe Salvi* que no estamos llamados a la comodidad, estamos llamados a algo mejor, a la grandeza. "El hombre fue creado para la grandeza, para Dios mismo; fue creado para ser llenado por Dios. Pero su corazón es demasiado pequeño para la grandeza a la que está destinado. Debe estirarse..." A veces, el estirarnos no es cómodo. Pero salir de nuestras zonas de comodidad le permite a Dios hacer cosas asombrosas. Cuando salimos, los estereotipos se rompen, las cosmovisiones se invierten y las etiquetas se destruyen. Hoy, en este momento, Jesús nos está llamando a ustedes y a mí a salir, dejar atrás lo que nos hace sentir cómodos y comenzar el viaje del discipulado. Esto significa que ya no solo nos rodeamos de personas y cosas que nos hacen sentir bien con nosotros mismos, sino que salimos con un sentido de aventura a lo desconocido. Como vemos en la Biblia, cuando los discípulos dejan la comodidad a favor de seguir a Jesús, comienzan a hacer cosas locas y sorprendentes como caminar sobre el agua (Mt. 14:29); Hablar de una manera que todos entiendan, independientemente del idioma (Hechos 2: 7-12); Sanar a los cojos (Hechos 3: 6); e incluso resucitar a los muertos (Hechos 20:10). Dios quiere hacer cosas asombrosas con nosotros, quiere terminar con la opresión, la intolerancia racial, alimentar a los pobres, educar a los que no tienen educación, amar a los que han sido marginados y proclamar su Buena Nueva de salvación. Todo esto comienza con el rechazo de lo que nos hace sentir cómodos.



A "DIFFICULT CHOICE"

Advocates of abortion often refer to the decision to have an abortion as a "difficult choice."

Why is it a difficult choice? The reason is very simple and obvious. We all know that the unborn child is a person growing inside the mother's womb. So, of course, it is "difficult". Choosing to terminate the life of another human being is a "difficult choice". If the unborn child was not a person, what would be so difficult about choosing to end his or her life?

Is killing a cancer growing inside your body a "difficult choice" . Of course not.

Dehumanizing the child is a vital strategy used by pro-abortionists to disguise the "difficult choice" that is being made. The baby is made to appear like the invading "blob of tissue"----like a cancerous growth. Why do we allow such deceit and victimization of the pre-born? Can you find a more innocent or vulnerable human being than a precious baby boy or girl inside his/her mother's womb? *The word "choice" (as used on the subject of abortion) is probably the most misleading and deceptive term in the English language.*

While it might sound good to say that government should allow people to make all their own choices, that is neither practical nor desirable. Some choices are crimes. All crimes are choices. Once a woman is pregnant, barring a miscarriage or an induced abortion, she will have a baby. Therefore, her only "choice" is, "How is the baby going to come out? "Will he or she come out alive and crying, or dead and in pieces? Truly, her choice is between life and death---a live baby, or a dead one.
