ANGELS ARE AWESOME

Jesus mentions that when we enter into the glory of God's Kingdom, that we "are like angels" (Lk 20:36). Many Catholics have some misunderstandings about Angels. Some erroneously believe that we become Angels when we die. We do not become angels, angels were created as angels, though God allows those who die in Christ to enjoy immortality, to join the angels in praising him forever, we still maintain our human nature. Angels were created as angels. The mention of Angels in this week's gospel provides an opportunity to share some angel facts:

Angels are fiercely awesome creatures. They wield powerful weapons to serve the glory of God. They are not cute, fat babies. They are truly awesome. When people encounter angels in the scriptures, they are filled with fear and often fall to the ground, believing that they are seeing God himself. Angels are more terrible, fierce and powerful than anything we can imagine.

And yes, they are real. This is an article of faith for Catholics as taught by the Catechism "The existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that Sacred Scripture usually calls 'angels' is a truth of faith. The witness of Scripture is as clear as the unanimity of Tradition." (CCC 328) They were created by God to minister to him. And yes, there are also fallen angels, those who have turned away from God and seek to drive man away from him. Jesus himself testifies that he saw the devil and his angels fall from heaven (Lk 10:18). We must acknowledge that there are both good and bad angels.



We also acknowledge that God has placed at least one Angel in charge of every human being. Angels wishing to do God's will, will help to guide and protect us. They pray for us and can intervene on our behalf. "For he will give his angels charge of you to guard you in all your ways." (Ps 91:11) And they are good advocates to have. Their intellect is more brilliant than Einstein, Steven Hawking, Socrates, and Shakespeare combined. They can move the heavens and the earth if God permits. Their powers are far beyond that of any fictional character that pen could ever describe.

Angels are keenly aware of us, though we do not see them. They join us at Mass as we praise God, they fall in prostrate before the altar of God, revering our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. Singing his praise, when we do so, we join with them.

In this world we need the Angels that serve God to come to our aid. Recognizing this, in 1886, pope Leo XIII asked that the prayer to St. Michael be added to the end of every low Mass. Michael, being venerated as the "Prince of the Angels" is revealed to have command over God's army. Unfortunately, the uniform practice of this prayer fell out of place in the age following the Second Vatican Council. In September of last year, given the state of the Church, Pope Francis asked that we revive and pray this ancient prayer. Out of obedience to the Holy Father, and in response to the apparent state of the Church and acknowledging our own need for the assistance of the Angels, we have reclaimed the practice of saying this prayer at the end of every Mass at St. Elizabeth Seton.

Bautizos Para poder bautizar en nuestra comunidad, la familia tiene que estar registrada en la parroquia un mínimo de tres meses antes del Bautismo con asistencia regular a la Santa Misa. Por favor, al registrarse en la parroquia, utilizar los sobres con el número de su familia en la colecta como prueba de participación y de asistencia a la Santa Misa.

Matrimonios Se debe hacer una cita con el Padre Luis para abrir el expediente matrimonial por lo menos 6 meses antes de la fecha de Boda. Hay que estar registrados en la parroquia un mínimo de seis meses antes de abrir el expediente matrimonial con asistencia regular a la Santa Misa. Se necesitan las partidas de bautismo ACTUALIZADAS no más de seis meses y han de ser originales, no copias.

Quinceañeras Las quinceañeras tienen que haber hecho la Primera Comunión y necesitan comprobante de haberlo hecho. La familia tiene que estar inscrita en la parroquia un mínimo de seis meses antes de reservar la Iglesia para la quinceañera con asistencia regular a la Santa Misa y ha de estar activa o en la doctrina o en el grupo juvenil o en un grupo parroquial con asistencia regular comprobada.

Confesiones El Padre Luis confiesa por 1 hora todos los Sábados antes de la Santa Misa. Aquellos que deseen confesarse, por favor, llegar a la Iglesia por lo menos media hora antes de la Santa Misa.

LOS ÁNGELES SON SORPRENDENTES

Jesús menciona que cuando entramos en la gloria del Reino de Dios, "somos como ángeles" (Lucas 20:36). Muchos católicos tienen algunos malentendidos sobre los ángeles. Algunos creen erróneamente que cuando morimos nos convertimos en Ángeles. No nos convertimos en ángeles, los ángeles fueron creados como ángeles, aunque Dios permite que aquellos que mueren en Cristo disfruten de la inmortalidad y se unan a los ángeles para alabarlo por siempre, aún mantenemos nuestra naturaleza humana. Los ángeles fueron creados como ángeles. La mención de los ángeles en el evangelio de esta semana brinda la oportunidad de compartir algunos datos sobre los ángeles:

Los ángeles son criaturas ferozmente asombrosas. Manejan armas poderosas para servir a la gloria de Dios. No son bebés lindos y gordos. Son realmente asombrosos. En las Escrituras, cuando las personas se encuentran con ángeles, se llenan de miedo y a menudo caen al suelo, creyendo que están viendo al mismo Dios. Los ángeles son más terribles, feroces y poderosos que cualquier cosa que podamos imaginar.

Y sí, son reales. Este es un artículo de fe para los católicos tal como lo enseña el Catecismo "La existencia de los seres espirituales, no corporales que la Sagrada Escritura usualmente llama" ángeles "es una verdad de fe. El testimonio de la Escritura es tan claro como la unanimidad de la tradición." (CIC 328) Fueron creados por Dios para ministrarle. Y sí, también hay ángeles caídos, aquellos que se han alejado de Dios y buscan alejar al hombre de él. Jesús mismo testifica que vio al diablo y a sus ángeles caer del cielo (Lc 10, 18). Debemos reconocer que hay ángeles buenos y malos.

También reconocemos que Dios ha puesto al menos un ángel a cargo de cada ser humano. Los ángeles que deseen hacer la voluntad de Dios ayudarán a guiarnos y protegernos. Rezan por nosotros y pueden intervenir en nuestro nombre. "Porque él dará a sus ángeles la orden de que te proteja en todos tus caminos". (Sal 91:11) Y son buenos defensores que tenemos. Su intelecto es más brillante que el de Einstein, Steven Hawking, Sócrates y Shakespeare. Pueden mover los cielos y la tierra si Dios lo permite. Sus poderes están mucho más allá de cualquier personaje ficticio que el lápiz pueda describir.

Los ángeles son muy conscientes de nosotros, aunque no los vemos. Se unen a nosotros en la misa cuando alabamos a Dios, se postran ante el altar de Dios, dando reverencia a nuestro Señor en el Santísimo Sacramento. Cantando su alabanza, cuando lo hacemos, nos unimos a ellos.

En este mundo necesitamos que los ángeles que sirven a Dios vengan en nuestra ayuda. Reconociendo esto, en 1886, el papa León XIII pidió que la oración a San Miguel arcángel se agregara al final de cada misa. Michael, siendo venerado como el "Príncipe de los Ángeles" se revela que tiene el mando sobre el ejército de Dios. Desafortunadamente, la práctica uniforme de esta oración cayó fuera de lugar en la era posterior al Concilio Vaticano II. En septiembre del año pasado, dado el estado de la Iglesia, el Papa Francisco pidió que reviviéramos y rezáramos esta antigua oración. Por obediencia al Santo Padre y en respuesta al aparente estado de la Iglesia y reconociendo nuestra propia necesidad de la ayuda de los Ángeles, hemos reclamado la práctica de decir esta oración al final de cada Misa en St. Elizabeth Seton.
