THE BLESSED SEASON OF ADVENT HAS COME UPON US!

The blessed season of Advent has come upon us! We are blessed to be reminded to take the time to reflect on our relationship with Jesus and examine what we are doing now and here, in this moment, to welcome Christ into our lives. Jesus Christ is the King of Kings who was, is, and is so to come. As we both look forward to welcome him when he comes in Glory, and prepare to welcome him in our Christmas celebrations, we have many opportunities to come and experience his presence among us and make room for him in our hearts.

Here are some ways we as a parish, can come together to celebrate this advent season:

- Thursday, December 5th: we will have a Penance service at 6:30 with several priests to hear confessions in English and Spanish.
- Monday, December 9: we will begin our Parish Mission at 7:00PM with a bilingual Mass for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary followed by a presentation from our Mission Speaker Dr. Scott Hefflefinger of the Augustine institute.
- Tuesday, December 10: at 7PM we will continue with our Parish Mission including a time of Praise and Worship with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
- Thursday, December 12: we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of the Americas, with Mañanitas (morning praise) at 5:00 AM. We will have our Bishop with us to celebrate a bilingual Mass at 7:00PM followed by a celebration of dance and a Guadalupe pageant performed by our Faith Formation Children.
- Friday, December 13: at 6:30 PM in our school gym, Our Seton Students will host a Christmas Concert.
- Tuesday, December 17: We again gather for praise and worship with Adoration of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament at 7:00PM with confessions heard at 6:00PM.
- And of course, as always, we celebrate Mass daily at 8:00 AM.

It is my hope that you can join us for all or at least some of these great opportunities to prepare our hearts to meet Christ, Our Savior!

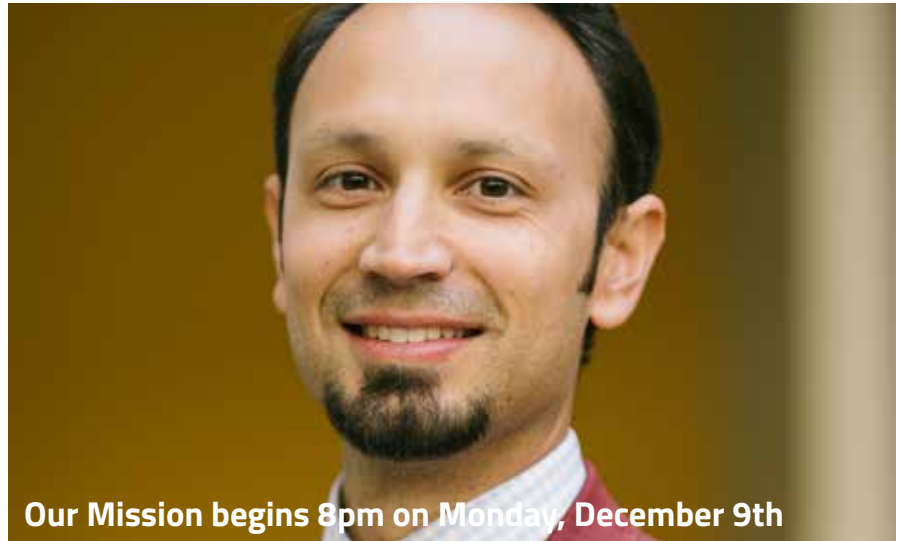
DO YOU KNIT OR CROCHET?

Scott Hefelfinger serves on the faculty of the Augustine Institute Graduate School of Theology. A California native, Scott studied music composition at U.C. Berkeley. While there, a powerful rediscovery of the Catholic faith led him to serve for a year as a missionary with NET Ministries; this service was followed by further studies at the International Theological Institute in Austria and the University of Notre Dame, where he completed a PhD in Moral Theology. Drawing on his experience with art, traveling missionary work, and the richness of family life, Dr. Hefelfinger has taught internationally on a wide variety of topics, most of which center on Christ's promise of "life in abundance" (Jn 10:10). He speaks regularly on morality, prayer, and family life at parishes and conferences. He and his wife, along with their three children, live in Centennial, CO, and love how the Rockies remind them of the Austrian Alps.

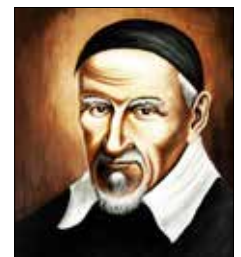

Through the generosity and Catholic Legacy of parish and school families, St. Elizabeth Seton Catholic School presently has two endowment funds with the Catholic Community Foundation of Southwest Florida. Endowment funds are designed to assist in providing long-term stability and sustainability beyond a donor's lifetime.

By creating or participating in endowment funds, donors both confirm and extend beyond their lifetime a commitment and conviction to Christ Jesus' mission and ministry of the Gospel proclamation of God's Kingdom among us. Additionally, endowment funds secure St. Elizabeth Seton Catholic Church and the School's future to form disciples and apostles of Christ Jesus for our community and the community-at-large. If we as a faith community and school seek to discern and respond to the future, we must plan for it as well.



Once an endowment is established, it is open to anyone wanting to contribute, in any amount desired. The endowment funds are structured so that the original gift amount (or principal) remains intact, while the investment earnings are used to support our parish and/or school. This creates a reliable and consistent revenue stream to help supplement funding for programs, ministries, future construction, and the needs for St. Elizabeth Seton Catholic Church and the School's future.

Many endowment funds are created through gifts from wills or trusts, however, several donors choose to fund endowments while they are still living, so that they can see the fruit and impact of their commitment and support. 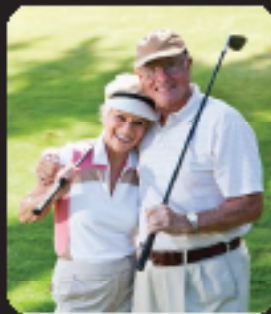

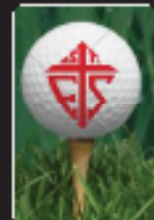
