A NOTE CONCERNING MASS INTENTIONS

Every Mass, as an offering of the one Eucharist, the once-and-for-all Sacrifice of Jesus Christ, is celebrated for one intention: the Salvation of The World. There is a longstanding custom offering a stipend to the priest to bear a special intention in his heart as he approaches the altar, as explained by Rev. Edward McNamara, professor of liturgy at the Regina Apostolorum Pontifical University in Rome: "Because of the particular role of the priest...acting ["in the Person of Christ"] when offering the holy sacrifice of the Mass, it is usually considered that special graces may be obtained when he applies the Mass to a particular intention." It must be understood that "The person who has offered the stipend has not 'bought a Mass,' a thing which is patently

impossible. What has happened is that the priest has committed himself to celebrate a Mass according to the intentions of the person making the offering."

Further, Fr. MacNamara explains that the intention of the priest celebrating the Mass is a spiritual act: "Because the intention is essentially a spiritual act, its publication neither adds nor subtracts from its efficacy." Therefore, announcing the intention adds no benefit to the person or persons who make up the intention of the celebrant. Indeed, practices at parishes vary: "Some parishes are content with posting a notice on a bulletin board or on its weekly broadsheet.

HERE IS YOUR GOD: SCOTT HAHN ON THE 3RD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

John questions Jesus from prison in today's Gospel—for his disciples' sake and for ours.

He knows that Jesus is doing "the works of the Messiah," foretold in today's First Reading and Psalm. But John wants his disciples—and us—to know that the Judge is at the gate, that in Jesus our God has come to save us.

The Liturgy of Advent takes us out into the desert to see and hear the marvelous works and words of God—the lame leaping like a stag, the dead raised, the good news preached to the poor (see Isaiah 29:18–20; 61:1–2).

The Liturgy does this to give us courage, to strengthen our feeble hands and make firm our weak knees. Our hearts can easily become frightened and weighed down by the hardships we face. We can lose patience in our sufferings as we await the coming of the Lord.

As James advises in today's Epistle, we should take as our example the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.

Jesus also points us to a prophet—holding up John as a model. John knew that life was more than food, the body more than clothing. He sought the kingdom of God first, confident that God would provide (see Matthew 6:25–34). John did not complain. He did not lose faith. Even in chains in his prison cell, he was still sending his disciples—and us—to our Savior.

We come to Him again now in the Eucharist. Already He has caused the desert to bloom, the burning sands to become springs of living water. He has opened our ears to hear the words of the sacred book, freed our tongue to fill the air with songs of thanksgiving (see Isaiah 30:18).

Once bowed down, captives to sin and death, we have been ransomed and returned to His Kingdom, crowned with everlasting joy. Raised up we now stand before His altar to meet the One who is to come: "Here is your God."

MASS INTENTIONS CONTINUED

Others prefer to announce the intention before Mass begins; others immediately after the greeting. Still others insert the name during the general intercessions. Any one of these solutions is possible. It is not liturgically correct...to habitually insert the name in the Eucharistic prayer, as this option is reserved to Masses for the dead such as funerals, first anniversaries, etc.” Just to be clear, Macnamara adds: “Sometimes, mishaps can occur, such as when a priest forgets to read out a name or cannot find it. In this case it is enough that he celebrated according to the intention of the donor.” We believe in the spiritual efficacy of the Mass, and this is why we have special intentions for the priest. A Mass intention does not exist as a means of memorializing a loved one, it is not there to ask the entire congregation to pray for a particular intention. It is there for the priest to bear in his heart as he, in the person of Jesus Christ, offers the Holy Sacrifice for the Salvation of the world so the person or persons of his intention may receive grace.
