# “BUT I SAY UNTO YOU...” CHRIST CALLS US TO A HIGHER MORAL STANDARD

There are many erroneous conceptions of Jesus floating about in the culture of today. For example, many people claim that Jesus is one among many great founders and leaders of world religions. Others claim that Jesus was a great moral leader. The problem with these claims is that Jesus did not claim to be any of these things; Jesus claimed to be God Incarnate. So, when looking at Sacred Scripture, these imposed caricatures of Jesus fall flat.

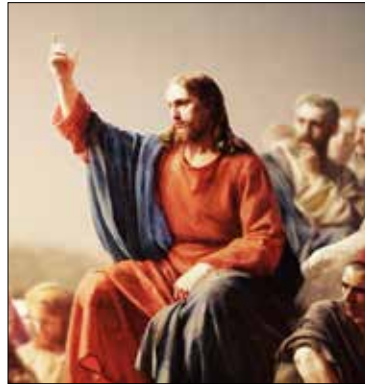
Another caricature of Jesus is even observed and embraced is the notions of what some have called “Hippie Jesus” Scripture Scholar, Dr. John Bergsma Explains:

“The ‘Hippie’ Jesus is one of the common misunderstandings of Christ that are circulating in popular culture. People think of Jesus as a laid back guru who traveled around Israel in this Volkswagen Vanagon, accompanied by twelve dudes in tie-dyed T-shirts. Jesus taught that all we need is Love, and not to be so uptight, like all those rule-bound priests and scribes.” In other words, Jesus came to stick it to “the man” because the pharisees made all these “rules” so any form of “rules” (i.e. Catholic Moral Teaching) are counter to Jesus who really just wants us to be groovy with one another.

The issue with this line of thinking is that Jesus didn’t have issues with the Pharisees for observance of a strict moral code, but rather for getting the code wrong. His issues with the Pharisees are, that they missed the heart of the law (Love of God and Love of Neighbor) and therefore interpreted the Law wrong, allowing miniscule items like ritual purity supersedes mercy and compassion. Additionally, he calls out the pharisees because they did not practice what they preached (hypocrisy). His issue with the morality of the pharisees is not the strictness of their observance of the Law, but that they got the law wrong.

For example, when the Letter of the Law says that we shall not murder. Can someone be morally upright if he goes about life not killing anyone, but kills someone’s spirit with unkind words, destroyed reputations with gossip, and assassinates someone’s character with slander? The Letter of the Law, says that we shall not worship anyone besides the Lord our God. Does this mean that someone who neglects prayer, never renders God worship, places more emphasis on money, power and pleasure than on pursuing God’s will, yet never actually erects an altar to Zeus is actually in God’s will? Of course not, the whole point of the Law of the Lord is to lead us to Love God and neighbor more, so we can be obedient to the letter.

Six times, in the fifth Chapter of St. Matthew’s Gospel, Jesus presents us with the formula “You have heard it, said..., but I say unto you...” Then, Jesus presents us with a difficult teaching such as what we read today “Love your enemies.” This is an immensely difficult teaching and a challenge. Jesus does challenge the teaching of the Pharisees not because it was too demanding or difficult, but rather he calls us to a HIGHER moral standard, to strive to love one another with the perfect love of our Heavenly Father and knowing that we all fall short of this standard of perfection, he will offer us his very self in reparation for our own shortcomings. The standard is perfection, and we all fall short. Thank God for the grace and salvation offered us in Jesus Christ. -Fr Casey

# “PERO YO TE DIGO ...” CRISTO NOS LLAMA A UN ESTÁNDAR MORAL SUPERIOR

Hay muchas concepciones erróneas de Jesús, flotando en la cultura de hoy. Por ejemplo, muchas personas afirman que Jesús es uno de los muchos grandes fundadores y líderes de las religiones mundiales. Otros afirman que Jesús fue un gran líder moral. El problema con estas afirmaciones es que Jesús no afirmó ser ninguna de estas cosas; Jesús afirmó ser Dios encarnado. Entonces, al mirar la Sagrada Escritura, estas caricaturas impuestas de Jesús caen de plano. Incluso se observa y abraza otra caricatura de Jesús: las nociones de lo que algunos han llamado el erudito de las Escrituras “Jesús Hippie”, explica el Dr. John Bergsma:

“El” Hippie “Jesús es uno de los malentendidos comunes de Cristo que circulan en la cultura popular. La gente piensa en Jesús como un gurú relajado que viajó por Israel en este Volkswagen Vanagon, acompañado por doce tipos con camisetas teñidas. Jesús enseñó que todo lo que necesitamos es Amor y no ser tan tenso, como todos esos sacerdotes y escribas sujetos a reglas”. En otras palabras, Jesús llegó a adherirse al “hombre” porque los fariseos hicieron todas estas “reglas”, por lo que cualquier forma de “reglas” (es decir, la enseñanza moral católica) es contraria a Jesús, que realmente quiere que seamos maravillosos unos con otros.

El problema con esta línea de pensamiento es que Jesús no tuvo problemas con los fariseos por la observancia de un código moral estricto, sino por equivocarse. Sus problemas con los fariseos son que extrañaron el corazón de la ley (Amor de Dios y Amor al prójimo) y por lo tanto, interpretaron mal la Ley, permitiendo que elementos minúsculos como la pureza ritual reemplacen la misericordia y la compasión. Además, llama a los fariseos porque no practicaron lo que predicaron (hipocresía). Su problema con la moralidad de los fariseos no es la rigurosidad de su observancia de la Ley, sino que se equivocaron.

Por ejemplo, cuando la Carta de la Ley dice que no asesinaremos. ¿Puede alguien ser moralmente recto cuando va por la vida sin matar a nadie, pero mata el espíritu de alguien con palabras desagradables, destruye reputaciones con chismes y asesina el carácter de alguien con calumnias? La Carta de la Ley dice que no adoraremos a nadie más que al Señor nuestro Dios. ¿Significa esto que alguien que descuida la oración, nunca rinde culto a Dios, pone más énfasis en el dinero, el poder y el placer que, en la búsqueda de la voluntad de Dios, pero nunca levanta un altar a Zeus que está realmente en la voluntad de Dios? Por supuesto que no, el objetivo de la Ley del Señor es llevarnos a amar más a Dios y al prójimo, para que podamos ser obedientes a la carta.

Seis veces, en el quinto capítulo del Evangelio de San Mateo, Jesús nos presenta la fórmula “Lo has escuchado, dijo ... pero yo te digo ...” Entonces, Jesús nos presenta una enseñanza difícil como la que leemos hoy. “Ama a tus enemigos.” Esta es una enseñanza inmensamente difícil y un desafío. 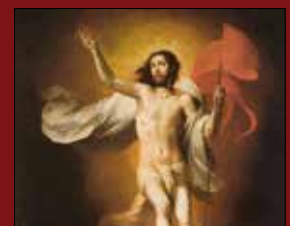
